AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to exempting the manufacturers of firearm silencers from certain provisions of such law

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph 8 of subdivision a of section 265.20 of the penal 2 law, as amended by chapter 189 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read 3 as follows:

4 8. The manufacturer of machine-guns, FIREARM SILENCERS, assault weapons, large capacity ammunition feeding devices, disguised guns, pilum 5 б ballistic knives, switchblade or gravity knives, billies or blackjacks 7 as merchandise, OR AS A TRANSFEREE RECIPIENT OF THE SAME FOR REPAIR, LAWFUL DISTRIBUTION OR RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT, and the disposal and 8 shipment thereof direct to a regularly constituted or appointed state or 9 10 municipal police department, sheriff, policeman or other peace officer, 11 or to a state prison, penitentiary, workhouse, county jail or other institution for the detention of persons convicted or accused of crime 12 held as witnesses in criminal cases, or to the military service of 13 or this state or of the United States; OR FOR THE REPAIR AND RETURN OF THE 14 15 SAME TO THE LAWFUL POSSESSOR OR FOR RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT.

16 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
