AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to stan-  
dards for premises licensed to sell alcoholic beverages for off-prem-  
ises consumption

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 105 of the alcoholic beverage  
2 control law, as amended by chapter 536 of the laws of 1966, is amended  
3 to read as follows:  
4     2. No premises shall be licensed to sell liquors and/or wines at  
5 retail for off premises consumption, unless said premises shall be  
6 located in a store, [the principal entrance] ALL ENTRANCES to which  
7 shall be from [the street level and located on a public thoroughfare in  
8 premises which may be occupied, operated or conducted for business,  
9 trade or industry or on] A PUBLIC THOROUGHFARE, an arcade or sub-surface  
10 thoroughfare leading to a railroad terminal[. There may be not more than  
11 one additional entrance which shall be from the street level and located  
12 on and giving access to and from] OR a public or private parking lot or  
13 parking area having space for not less than five automobiles.  
14     S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
