AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to trustees of the state university and city university

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 353 of the education law, as amended by chapter 127 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as follows:

4 state university shall be governed, and all of its corporate powers exercised, by a board of trustees. Such board shall consist of 6 seventeen members, fifteen of whom shall be appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate, one of whom shall be 7 8 the student assembly of the state university, ex-officio president of 9 and voting; PROVIDED THAT NO SUCH MEMBER, EXCEPT THE PRESIDENT STUDENT ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE UNIVERSITY OR ANY CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE 10 THE EMPLOYEE OF, OR UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF, THE 11 EMPLOYEE, SHALL BE GOVERNOR, and one of whom shall be the president of the 12 university faculty senate, ex-officio and non-voting. Such ex-officio members shall 13 subject to every provision of any general, special, or local law, 14 15 ordinance, charter, code, rule, or regulation applying to the voting members of such board with respect to the discharge of their duties, 17 including, but not limited to, those provisions setting forth codes of ethics, disclosure requirements, and prohibiting business and profes-18

sional activities. One member of the board shall be designated by the governor as chairperson and one as vice-chairperson. Of the members 3 first appointed, two shall be appointed for a term which shall expire on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred fifty-two; one for a term which shall 5 expire on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred fifty-three; two for a term 6 which shall expire on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred fifty-four; one 7 for a term which shall expire on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred 8 fifty-five; two for a term which shall expire on June thirtieth, nine-9 teen hundred fifty-six; one for a term which shall expire on June thir-10 tieth, nineteen hundred fifty-seven; two for a term which shall expire on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred fifty-eight; one for a term which 11 12 shall expire on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred fifty-nine; two for a 13 term which shall expire on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred sixty; 14 for a term which shall expire on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred 15 sixty-one. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term in the same manner as original appointments. The term of office of each trustee appointed on or after April first, nineteen hundred eighty-six shall be 16 17 seven years, except those of the student member and the faculty member. 18 19 Trustees shall receive no compensation for their services but shall be 20 reimbursed for their expenses actually and necessarily incurred by them 21 in the performance of their duties under this article. 22

- S 2. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 6204 of the education law, as added by chapter 305 of the laws of 1979, is amended to read as follows:
- (a) The board of trustees shall consist of seventeen trustees. Ten of trustees shall be appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate; PROVIDED THAT NO SUCH TRUSTEE, EXCEPT ANY CLASSI-FIED CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEE, SHALL BE AN EMPLOYEE OF, OR UNDER SUPERVISION OF, THE GOVERNOR. Five of the trustees shall be appointed by the mayor of the city of New York with the advice and consent of the senate; PROVIDED THAT NO SUCH TRUSTEE, EXCEPT ANY CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEE OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK, SHALL BE AN EMPLOYEE OF, UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF, THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK. One ex-officio trustee shall be the chairperson of the university student senate. 35 One ex-officio non-voting trustee shall be the chairperson of the university faculty senate.
- S 3. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to board 37 38 members of the state university of New York and trustees of the city 39 university of New York appointed on or after such effective date.
