- AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law and the public health law, in relation to an environmental facility and cancer incidence map; to repeal certain provisions of such laws relating thereto; to repeal section 3 of chapter 638 of the laws of 2008 amending the environmental conservation law and the public health law relating to the environmental facility and cancer incidence map relating to the collection of information for reported cases of cancer and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 3-0317 of the environmental conservation law is 2 REPEALED and a new section 3-0317 is added to read as follows:

3 S 3-0317. CANCER INCIDENCE AND ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITY MAPS PROJECT.

4 1. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITY" SHALL MEAN A 5 FACILITY OR SITE WHICH IS:

6 (A) PERMITTED AS AN INDUSTRIAL OR MUNICIPAL FACILITY PURSUANT TO 7 TITLES 7 OR 8 OF ARTICLE 17 OF THIS CHAPTER;

(B) REGISTERED PURSUANT TO TITLE 10 OF ARTICLE 17 OF THIS CHAPTER;

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(C) PERMITTED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 19 OF THIS CHAPTER; 1 2 (D) PERMITTED OR REGISTERED PURSUANT TO TITLE 7 OR 9 OF ARTICLE 27 OF 3 THIS CHAPTER; 4 (E) REQUIRED TO FILE AN ANNUAL REPORT PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION 6 OF 5 SECTION 27-0907 OF THIS CHAPTER; 6 (F) REGULATED PURSUANT TO TITLE 13 OR 14 OF ARTICLE 27 OF THIS CHAP-7 TER; 8 (G) REGULATED AS A VEHICLE DISMANTLER PURSUANT TO TITLE 23 OF ARTICLE 9 27 OF THIS CHAPTER; 10 (H) PERMITTED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 29 OF THIS CHAPTER; HOLDER OF A COMMERCIAL PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 33-0901 OF 11 (I) A 12 THIS CHAPTER; (J) REGISTERED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 40 OF THIS CHAPTER; 13 14 (K) THE SUBJECT OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL RESTORATION PROJECT PURSUANT TO 15 TITLE 5 OF ARTICLE 56 OF THIS CHAPTER; (L) SUBJECT TO CORRECTIVE ACTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 71-2727 OF THIS 16 17 CHAPTER; (M) PARTICIPATING IN THE DEPARTMENT'S VOLUNTARY CLEANUP PROGRAM; OR 18 19 (N) LICENSED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 12 OF THE NAVIGATION LAW AS A MAJOR 20 OIL STORAGE FACILITY. 21 DEPARTMENT SHALL, PURSUANT TO ESTABLISHED SECURITY PROTOCOLS, 2. THE 22 PROVIDE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH THE GPS COORDINATES, CATEGORY OF 23 LICENSE OR PERMIT, FACILITY IDENTIFICATION NUMBER, AND ADDRESS ON CURRENT ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITIES THAT ARE NECESSARY FOR 24 THE DEPARTMENT 25 HEALTH TO DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN CANCER INCIDENCE AND ENVIRONMENTAL OF 26 FACILITY MAPS REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION TWENTY-FOUR HUNDRED ONE-B OF 27 THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW, AND SHALL PROVIDE ANY TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE NECES-SARY FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF SUCH MAPS. THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION 28 29 WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, SHALL UPDATE SUCH DATA PERIODICALLY. 3. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL WORK WITH THE OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY 30 TO ESTABLISH SECURITY PROTOCOLS REGARDING THE DISCLOSURE OF DATA ON CURRENT 31 32 ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITIES. 33 Section 2401-b of the public health law is REPEALED and a new S 2. 34 section 2401-b is added to read as follows: 35 S 2401-B. CANCER INCIDENCE AND ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITY MAPS. 1. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITY" SHALL HAVE THE SAME 36 37 MEANING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 3-0317 OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION 38 LAW. 39 2. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "CANCER INCIDENCE AND ENVIRONMENTAL 40 FACILITY MAPS TECHNICAL ADVISORY GROUP" OR "TECHNICAL ADVISORY GROUP" THE ENVIRONMENTAL PUBLIC HEALTH TRACKING PROGRAM TECHNICAL 41 SHALL MEAN 42 ADVISORY GROUP REQUIRED BY A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DEPART-43 MENT AND THE FEDERAL CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION. 44 3. THE TECHNICAL ADVISORY GROUP SHALL MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE 45 DEPARTMENT ON THE APPROPRIATE USE AND COMMUNICATION OF THE CANCER INCI-46 DENCE AND ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITY MAPS. SUCH RECOMMENDATIONS SHALL 47 CONSIDER THE SCIENTIFIC STRENGTHS AND LIMITATIONS OF SUCH MAPPING AND 48 OVERLAY METHODOLOGIES FOR CANCER TRACKING AND GEOSPATIAL LINKING TO SIGNIFICANT DISEASE RISK FACTORS, AND THE APPROPRIATE MEANS FOR COMMUNI-49 50 CATING SUCH STRENGTHS AND LIMITATION TO THE PUBLIC IN AN EASILY DISCERN-51 IBLE MANNER. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONSIDER THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THETECHNICAL ADVISORY GROUP WHEN MAKING THE MAPS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION 52 53 AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC. 54 4. THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRON-55 CONSERVATION AND THE TECHNICAL ADVISORY GROUP, SHALL ESTABLISH MENTAL 56 AND MAINTAIN A COMPUTER MAPPING SYSTEM FOR PLOTTING CANCER INCIDENCE AND

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ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITIES THROUGHOUT THE STATE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED 1 2 TO CANCER CLUSTERS. SUCH MAPS SHALL OVERLAY LOCATIONS OF ENVIRONMENTAL 3 FACILITIES WITH CANCER INCIDENCES. 4 5. CANCER INCIDENCE AND ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITY MAPS SHALL INCLUDE DATA 5 ON THE INCIDENCE OF THE FOLLOWING CANCER TYPES: 6

- (A) LUNG AND BRONCHUS;
- (B) FEMALE BREAST;
- (C) URINARY BLADDER (INCLUDING IN SITU);
- 9 (D) BRAIN AND OTHER NERVOUS SYSTEM;
- 10 (E) COLON AND RECTUM;
- 11 (F) NON-HODGKIN LYMPHOMAS;
- (G) LEUKEMIAS; 12
- 13 (H) THYROID;
- 14 (I) LIVER/INTRAHEPATIC BILE DUCT;
- (J) KIDNEY AND RENAL PELVIS; 15
- 16 (K) PROSTATE;
- 17 (L) ORAL CAVITY AND PHARYNX;
- 18 (M) STOMACH;
- 19 (N) ESOPHAGUS;
- 20 (O) LARYNX;
- 21 (P) PANCREAS;
- 22 (O) CORPUS UTERUS;
- 23 (R) OVARY;
- 24 (S) TESTIS;
- 25 (T) MESOTHELIOMA;
  - (U) BONE;
  - (V) NASAL AND NASOPHARYNX; AND
  - (W) SOFT TISSUE SARCOMAS.

29 PLOTTING OF DATA FOR CANCER INCIDENCE AND ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITY 6. MAPS SHALL BE BY CENSUS BLOCK, EXCEPT IN CASES WHERE SUCH PLOTTING COULD 30 DISCLOSE THE IDENTITY OF ANY PERSON TO WHOM THE DATA RELATE, IN WHICH 31 32 CASE CENSUS BLOCKS SHALL BE AGGREGATED FOR PLOTTING TO PROTECT THE IDEN-33 SUCH PERSON. WHEN SUCH AGGREGATION IS REQUIRED, THE DEPARTMENT TITY OF 34 SHALL UTILIZE THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF CENSUS BLOCKS PRACTICABLE TO PROTECT 35 THE IDENTITY OF SUCH PERSON.

36 7. BY MARCH FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE 37 AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC INFORMATION ON CANCER AS DESIGNATED BY THE ENVI-38 RONMENTAL PUBLIC HEALTH TRACKING PROGRAM OF THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION, AND, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF 39 40 ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION, CURRENT DATA ON LOCATIONS AND TYPE OF ENVI-41 RONMENTAL FACILITIES.

8. BY JUNE THIRTIETH, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN THE DEPARTMENT SHALL 42 MAKE 43 AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC CANCER INCIDENCE AND ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITY MAPS 44 WHICH SHOW AVAILABLE INFORMATION ON THE LOCATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL FACIL-45 ITIES AND THE TOTAL NUMBER OF REPORTED CANCERS BY CENSUS BLOCK AND ASSO-46 CIATED DATA FOR EACH REPORTED CANCER TYPE LISTED IN SUBDIVISION FIVE OF 47 THIS SECTION.

48 9. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC CANCER INCIDENCE 49 AND ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITY MAPS IN THE MANNER DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION FOUR OF THIS SECTION SHOWING CANCER CLUSTERS BY CANCER TYPES. 50 PRIOR ΤO PLOTTING SUCH DATA, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL USE AN APPROPRIATE STATISTICAL 51 52 METHOD TO DETECT STATISTICAL ANOMALIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF IDENTIFYING 53 CANCER CLUSTERS.

54 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE SUCH MAPS AVAILABLE AS FOLLOWS:

55 JUNE THIRTIETH, TWO THOUSAND TWELVE CANCER TYPES LISTED IN (I)ΒY PARAGRAPHS (A) THROUGH (E) OF SUBDIVISION FIVE OF THIS SECTION; 56

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(II) BY DECEMBER THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TWELVE CANCER TYPES LISTED
 IN PARAGRAPHS (F) THROUGH (O) OF SUBDIVISION FIVE OF THIS SECTION; AND
 (III) BY JUNE THIRTIETH, TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN CANCER TYPES LISTED IN

4 PARAGRAPHS (P) THROUGH (W) OF SUBDIVISION FIVE OF THIS SECTION.
5 (B) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRON6 MENTAL CONSERVATION, SHALL UPDATE THE MAPS PERIODICALLY.

7 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL POST THESE MAPS ON ITS PUBLIC WEBSITE AS SOON 8 AS PRACTICABLE FOLLOWING THE DATES SET FORTH IN PARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS 9 SUBDIVISION.

10 S 3. Paragraph (s) of subdivision 1 of section 206 and paragraph (i) 11 of subdivision 1 of section 2411 of the public health law are REPEALED.

12 S 4. Section 3 of chapter 638 of the laws of 2008 amending the envi-13 ronmental conservation law and the public health law relating to the 14 environmental facility and cancer incidence map is REPEALED.

15 S 5. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be 16 deemed repealed March 31, 2016.
