- AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to directing the city of Buffalo to adjudicate traffic infractions

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 229 to read as follows:

3 S 229. APPLICATION OF ARTICLE. THIS ARTICLE SHALL NOT APPLY TO THE 4 CITY OF BUFFALO. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS CHAPTER WITH REGARD TO THE ADJUDI-5 CATION OF ANY VIOLATION OF THIS CHAPTER OR OF A LAW, ORDINANCE, ORDER, 6 RULE OR REGULATION RELATING TO TRAFFIC, WHICH IS CLASSIFIED AS A TRAFFIC 7 INFRACTION, THE CITY OF BUFFALO SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE A CITY HAVING A 8 POPULATION OF LESS THAN TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY INCON-9 SISTENT PROVISION OF A GENERAL, SPECIAL OR LOCAL LAW TO THE CONTRARY, THE CITY OF BUFFALO SHALL PROVIDE BY LOCAL LAW FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE 10 ADJUDICATION OF TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS. ANY PERSON CHARGED WITH A TRAFFIC 11 INFRACTION BY THE CITY OF BUFFALO SHALL HAVE ALL THE RIGHTS TO 12 A HEAR-13 ING, ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUDICATION AND JUDICIAL REVIEW PURSUANT TO THIS CHAPTER AND ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW. THE CITY OF BUFFALO 14 SHALL HAVE ALL THE FUNCTIONS, POWERS AND DUTIES WITH RESPECT TO THE ADJUDICATION OF 15 16 TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS AS ARE GRANTED TO CITIES HAVING A POPULATION OF LESS 17 THAN TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND. TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS ADJUDICATED BY THE CITY OF BUFFALO SHALL BE PUNISHABLE BY A CIVIL PENALTY. ALL MONEYS 18 COLLECTED FROM SUCH ADJUDICATIONS SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED PURSUANT TO SECTION EIGH-19 TEEN HUNDRED THREE OF THIS CHAPTER. 20

S 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2011. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective date are authorized and directed to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
