AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to providing for the financing of certain facilities located on the campus of the United States Merchant Marine Academy

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 2 of section 1676 of the  
2     public authorities law is amended by adding a new undesignated paragraph  
3     to read as follows:  
4     THE UNITED STATES MARITIME RESOURCE CENTER FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANC-  
5     ING, REFINANCING, CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, DEVELOPMENT,  
6     EXPANSION AND EQUIPPING OF A FACILITY TO SERVE AS A CLASSROOM AND  
7     STUDENT RESIDENCE BUILDING IN SUPPORT OF PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION AND  
8     TRAINING PROGRAMS TO BE LOCATED ON THE CAMPUS OF THE UNITED STATES  
9     MERCHANT MARINE ACADEMY LOCATED IN KINGS POINT, NEW YORK.  
10    S 2. Subdivision 1 of section 1680 of the public authorities law is  
11    amended by adding a new undesignated paragraph to read as follows:  
12    THE UNITED STATES MARITIME RESOURCE CENTER FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANC-  
13    ING, REFINANCING, CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, DEVELOPMENT,  
14    EXPANSION AND EQUIPPING OF A FACILITY TO SERVE AS A CLASSROOM AND  
15    STUDENT RESIDENCE BUILDING IN SUPPORT OF PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION AND  
16    TRAINING PROGRAMS TO BE LOCATED ON THE CAMPUS OF THE UNITED STATES  
17    MERCHANT MARINE ACADEMY LOCATED IN KINGS POINT, NEW YORK.  
18    S 3. All contracts entered into by the dormitory authority pursuant to  
19    the provisions of this act shall be deemed to be state contracts for the  
20    purposes of article 15-A of the executive law, and the dormitory author-  
21    ity, for the purposes of this act, shall be deemed to be a contracting  
22    agency for the purposes of such article.  
23    S 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
