AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to making monetary gifts to libraries

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 612 of the tax law is amended by 2 adding a new paragraph 39 to read as follows:
- (39) AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR MONETARY GIFTS TO ANY LIBRARY IN THE STATE OF YORK AS DEFINED UNDER NEWSECTION TWO FIFTY-THREE OF THE EDUCATION LAW. THE MONEY MUST BE USED BY THE PARTICULAR LIBRARY ONLY FOR THE PURCHASE OF BOOKS AND LIBRARY 6 MATERIALS 7 ACQUISITION OF COMPUTERS AND SOFTWARE BY THE LIBRARY. TOWARDS THE8 WHEN THE GIFT OR GIFTS ARE MADE BY THE INDIVIDUAL, THE LIBRARY
- 9 PROVIDE THAT INDIVIDUAL WITH AN OFFICIAL RECEIPT.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to tax 11 years beginning on or after January 1, 2010.
