## IN SENATE

- Introduced by Sens. DUANE, KRUEGER -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Children and Families
- AN ACT to amend the domestic relations law, in relation to authorizing two unmarried adults to adopt a child

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The first undesignated paragraph of section 110 of the 2 domestic relations law, as amended by chapter 254 of the laws of 1991, 3 is amended to read as follows:

4 adult unmarried person [or], an adult husband and his adult wife An 5 together, OR ANY TWO UNMARRIED ADULTS TOGETHER may adopt another person. 6 An adult married person who is living separate and apart from his or her 7 spouse pursuant to a decree or judgment of separation or pursuant to a written agreement of separation subscribed by the parties thereto and 8 9 acknowledged or proved in the form required to entitle a deed to be recorded or an adult married person who has been living separate and 10 apart from his or her spouse for at least three years prior to commenc-11 ing an adoption proceeding may adopt another person; provided, however, 12 13 that the person so adopted shall not be deemed the child or step-child 14 of the non-adopting spouse for the purposes of inheritance or support rights or obligations or for any other purposes. An adult or minor 15 husband and his adult or minor wife together may adopt a child of either 16 17 them born in or out of wedlock and an adult or minor husband or an of 18 adult or minor wife may adopt such a child of the other spouse. No person shall hereafter be adopted except in pursuance of this article, 19 and in conformity with section three hundred seventy-three of the social 20 services law. 21
