to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to authorizing the imposition of certain terms and conditions as part of certain licenses for on-premises consumption

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 55 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended 2 by adding a new subdivision 4 to read as follows:
- 4. THE AUTHORITY MAY, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE APPLICANT, INCLUDE, PART OF A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSURING THAT THE LICENSED PREMISES ARE OPERATED IN ACCORD-WITH APPLICABLE LAW AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PUBLIC INTEREST. PRIOR 7 TO INCLUDING TERMS AND CONDITIONS IN A LICENSE, THE AUTHORITY 8 CONSULT WITH THE APPLICANT AND ANY PARTY ENTITLED TO RECEIVE NOTICE OF 9 THE APPLICATION. THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SHALL BE LEGALLY ENFORCEABLE 10 THE SAME MANNER AS APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER OR REGU-LATIONS OF THE AUTHORITY. 11
- 12 S 2. Section 64 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended by adding a new subdivision 10 to read as follows: 13
- THE AUTHORITY MAY, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE APPLICANT, INCLUDE, AS 14 15 PART OF A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSURING THAT THE LICENSED PREMISES ARE OPERATED IN ACCORD-16 17 ANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAW AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PUBLIC INTEREST. PRIOR TERMS AND CONDITIONS IN A LICENSE, THE AUTHORITY SHALL 18 INCLUDING
- CONSULT WITH THE APPLICANT AND ANY PARTY ENTITLED TO RECEIVE 19 NOTICE THE APPLICATION. THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SHALL BE LEGALLY ENFORCEABLE 20
- 21 IN THE SAME MANNER AS APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER OR REGU-
- 22 LATIONS OF THE AUTHORITY.

3. Section 64-a of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended by adding a new subdivision 5-a to read as follows:

5-A. THE AUTHORITY MAY, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE APPLICANT, INCLUDE, AS PART OF A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSURING THAT THE LICENSED PREMISES ARE OPERATED IN ACCORD-WITH APPLICABLE LAW AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PUBLIC INTEREST. PRIOR TO INCLUDING TERMS AND CONDITIONS IN A LICENSE, THE AUTHORITY CONSULT WITH THE APPLICANT AND ANY PARTY ENTITLED TO RECEIVE NOTICE OF THE APPLICATION. THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SHALL BE LEGALLY ENFORCEABLE THE SAME MANNER AS APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER OR REGU-LATIONS OF THE AUTHORITY.

- S 4. Section 64-b of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended by adding a new subdivision 5-a to read as follows:
- 5-A. THE AUTHORITY MAY, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE APPLICANT, INCLUDE, AS OF A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSURING THAT THE LICENSED PREMISES ARE OPERATED IN ACCORD-WITH APPLICABLE LAW AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PUBLIC INTEREST. PRIOR TO INCLUDING TERMS AND CONDITIONS IN A LICENSE, THE AUTHORITY WITH THE APPLICANT AND ANY PARTY ENTITLED TO RECEIVE NOTICE OF THE APPLICATION. THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SHALL BE LEGALLY ENFORCEABLE THE SAME MANNER AS APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER OR REGU-LATIONS OF THE AUTHORITY.
- S 5. Section 64-c of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended by 24 adding a new subdivision 5-a to read as follows:
 - 5-A. THE AUTHORITY MAY, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE APPLICANT, INCLUDE, AS PART OF A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSURING THAT THE LICENSED PREMISES ARE OPERATED IN ACCORD-WITH APPLICABLE LAW AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PUBLIC INTEREST. PRIOR TO INCLUDING TERMS AND CONDITIONS IN A LICENSE, THE AUTHORITY SHALL CONSULT WITH THE APPLICANT AND ANY PARTY ENTITLED TO RECEIVE NOTICE OF THE APPLICATION. THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SHALL BE LEGALLY ENFORCEABLE THE SAME MANNER AS APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER OR REGU-LATIONS OF THE AUTHORITY.
 - S 6. Section 64-d of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended by adding a new subdivision 5-a to read as follows:
- 5-A. THE AUTHORITY MAY, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE APPLICANT, INCLUDE, AS 36 37 OF A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE 38 PURPOSE OF ASSURING THAT THE LICENSED PREMISES ARE OPERATED IN ACCORD-39 WITH APPLICABLE LAW AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PUBLIC INTEREST. PRIOR 40 TO INCLUDING TERMS AND CONDITIONS IN A LICENSE, THE AUTHORITY CONSULT WITH THE APPLICANT AND ANY PARTY ENTITLED TO RECEIVE NOTICE OF 41 THE APPLICATION. THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SHALL BE LEGALLY ENFORCEABLE 42 43 SAME MANNER AS APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER OR REGU-44 LATIONS OF THE AUTHORITY.
- 45 S 7. This act shall take effect immediately.
