- AN ACT to authorize the city of New York to discontinue use of and convey certain park land

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subject to the provisions of this act, but notwithstanding 1 2 any provision of general, special or local law to the contrary, the city of New York is authorized to discontinue use as park land and to convey, 3 4 in fee simple, the land described in section three of this act. Such 5 land is authorized to be conveyed to the Saint Michael's Cemetery upon 6 such terms and conditions as the city council of the city of New York 7 shall determine to be fair and reasonable.

8 The authorization provided in section one of this act shall be S 2. 9 subject to the requirement that the city of New York shall use any 10 proceeds and/or land received in exchange for the conveyance authorized by this act to acquire land, to be dedicated for park purposes, in an 11 amount equal to or greater than the fair market value of the land being 12 13 conveyed pursuant to this act and/or used for capital improvements to existing park and recreational facilities. 14

15 S 3. The land authorized to be discontinued as park land and conveyed 16 is as follows:

17 ALL that certain plot, piece or parcel of land, lying and being in the 18 Borough and County of Queens, City and State of New York, bounded and 19 described as follows:

20 BEGINNING at the corner formed by the intersection of the westerly 21 side of Brooklyn-Queens Expressway East (Service Road), also known as
