- AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to the recording, broadcasting, webcasting and photographing of meetings of public bodies

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 103 of the public officers law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision (d) to read as follows:

3 (D) 1. MEETINGS OF PUBLIC BODIES SHALL BE OPEN TO RECORDING BY EITHER 4 AUDIO OR VIDEO, BROADCASTING, WEBCASTING OR PHOTOGRAPHING BY ANY PERSON 5 IN ATTENDANCE FROM ONE OR MORE DESIGNATED LOCATIONS AS REASONABLY DETER-6 MINED BY SUCH PUBLIC BODY, PROVIDED THAT SUCH RECORDING, BROADCASTING, 7 WEBCASTING OR PHOTOGRAPHING DOES NOT INTERFERE WITH THE CONDUCT OF THE 8 MEETING.

9 2. A PUBLIC BODY SHALL ADOPT RULES REASONABLY GOVERNING THE LOCATIONS 10 FOR RECORDING, BROADCASTING, WEBCASTING OR PHOTOGRAPHING OF MEETINGS, 11 PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT SUCH PUBLIC BODY SHALL NOT PROHIBIT OR DISCOUR-12 AGE SUCH RECORDING, BROADCASTING, WEBCASTING OR PHOTOGRAPHING. SUCH 13 RULES SHALL BE CONSPICUOUSLY POSTED DURING SUCH MEETINGS.

14 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 15 have become a law.
