AN ACT to amend the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law, in relation to rebates and free passes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law is amended by adding a new section 112 to read as follows:

3 1. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "REBATE" SHALL 112. REBATES. S 4 MEAN A PORTION OF PARI-MUTUEL WAGERS, OTHERWISE PAYABLE TO AN ASSOCI-5 ATION OR CORPORATION CONDUCTING PARI-MUTUEL BETTING AT A RACE MEETING ON 6 THEREAT, WHICH IS PAID TO HOLDERS OF PARI-MUTUEL WAGERING RACES RUN 7 TICKETS AND WHICH REDUCES THE AMOUNT OTHERWISE PAYABLE TO SUCH ASSOCI-8 ATION OR CORPORATION. REBATES SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, REFUNDS TO HOLDERS OF PARI-MUTUEL WAGERING TICKETS ON ANY PORTION OR 9 10 PERCENTAGE OF THE FULL FACE VALUE OF A PARI-MUTUEL WAGER, INCREASING THE OF OR PAYING A BONUS ON A WINNING PARI-MUTUEL TICKET, AWARDS OF 11 PAYOFF 12 MERCHANDISE, SERVICES SUCH AS MEALS, PARKING, ADMISSION, SEATING AND PROGRAMS, FREE OR REDUCED COST PARI-MUTUEL WAGERS, AND MONETARY AWARDS. 13 THE RACING AND WAGERING BOARD, UPON APPLICATION OF AN ASSOCIATION 14 2. 15 OR CORPORATION CONDUCTING PARI-MUTUEL BETTING AT A RACE MEETING ON RACES RUN THEREAT, MAY ANNUALLY APPROVE THE PAYMENT OF REBATES BY SUCH ASSOCI-16 17 ATION OR CORPORATION, SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

18 A. THE APPLICANT FULLY DISCLOSES THE EXTENT OF THE REBATE PROGRAM. 19 FULL DISCLOSURE SHALL INCLUDE THE DISCLOSURE OF THE MONETARY VALUE OF 20 ALL REBATES PAID TO BETTORS DURING THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR, AND THE 21 TERMS AND CONDITIONS GOVERNING THE AWARD OF REBATES TO BETTORS FOR THE 22 CALENDAR YEAR TO WHICH THE APPLICATION APPLIES;

B. THE APPLICANT PROVIDES ASSURANCES THAT THE VALUES OF THE REBATES 1 2 DETERMINED SOLELY BY (I) THE AMOUNT WAGERED BY A BETTOR, (II) THE ARE 3 AMOUNT PAYABLE TO THE ASSOCIATION OR CORPORATION ON EACH WAGER, AND 4 (III) HOW FREQUENTLY A BETTOR WAGERS; 5 ASSOCIATION OR CORPORATION MAINTAINS RECORDS OF ALL WAGERS C. THE 6 SUBJECT TO A REBATE, FOR A PERIOD OF NOT LESS THAN THREE YEARS; AND 7 D. THE APPLICANT DEMONSTRATES THAT SUCH REBATES ARE IN THE BEST INTER-8 ESTS OF HORSE RACING. 9 3. REGIONAL OFF-TRACK BETTING CORPORATIONS MAY OFFER REBATES ON WAGERS 10 MADE ON RACES RUN BY ANY ASSOCIATION OR CORPORATION WHICH OFFERS REBATES SECTION. REBATES 11 PURSUANT TO THIS SUCH SHALL BE SUBJECT ТΟ THE 12 PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISIONS ONE AND TWO OF THIS SECTION. APPROVAL OF AN ASSOCIATION OR CORPORATION CONDUCTING 13 4. UPON THE 14 PARI-MUTUEL BETTING AT A RACE MEETING ON RACES RUN THEREAT, ANOTHER 15 RACING ASSOCIATION OR CORPORATION MAY PROVIDE BETTORS WITH REBATES ON 16 WAGERS ON RACES RUN AT THE RACETRACK OPERATED BY SUCH APPROVING ASSOCI-SHALL BE 17 ATION OR CORPORATION. ALL SUCH REBATES SUBJECT ΤO THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISIONS ONE AND TWO OF THIS SECTION. 18 19 S 2. Section 243 of the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law, 20 as amended by chapter 18 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as 21 follows: 22 243. Free passes, cards or badges. A corporation licensed or fran-S chised to conduct pari-mutuel betting on races run on its racetrack[, 23 24 shall not] MAY issue free passes, cards or badges [except] to [persons 25 hereafter described:] ANY QUALIFIED PERSON. QUALIFIED PERSON SHALL 26 INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, officers and employees of the corporation conducting the race meeting, members, officers and employees of 27 the state racing and wagering board, members and employees of the jockey 28 29 club, members and employees of the national steeplechase and hunt association, members of turf organizations of other states and foreign coun-30 tries, public officers engaged in the performance of their duties, 31 32 persons actually employed and accredited by the press to attend such 33 meetings, owners, stable managers, trainers, jockeys, jockey managers, grooms, concessionaires, spouses, domestic partners and children of owners, trainers and jockeys, [and] other persons whose actual duties 34 35 require their presence at such racetrack, AND ANY OTHER PERSON OR GUEST 36 DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY SUCH CORPORATION. IN ADDITION, FREE PASSES, CARDS 37 38 BADGES MAY BE ISSUED TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC IN CONNECTION WITH ANY OR 39 PROMOTIONAL CAMPAIGN OR MARKETING PROGRAM SPONSORED BY SUCH CORPORATION 40 INCREASE ATTENDANCE AT LIVE RACE MEETS. The issuance of free passes, ТΟ cards or badges shall be under the rules and regulations of the state 41 racing and wagering board [and a list of all persons to whom free pass-42 43 es, cards or badges are issued shall be filed with the state racing and 44 wagering board]. 45 3. Section 324 of the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law S is amended to read as follows: 46 47 S 324. Free passes, cards or badges. A corporation or association 48 licensed to conduct pari-mutuel betting on harness horse races run at its racetrack [shall not] MAY issue free passes, cards or [except] to [persons hereafter described:] ANY QUALIFIED PERSON. 49 cards or badges 50 OUALI-FIED PERSON SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, officers and employees 51 the corporation or association conducting the race meeting, members, 52 of

53 officers and employees of the state racing and wagering board, members 54 of harness racing associations of other states and foreign countries, 55 public officers engaged in the performance of their duties, persons 56 actually employed and accredited by the press to attend such meetings,

owners, stable managers, trainers, drivers, concessionaires [and], 1 2 SPOUSES, DOMESTIC PARTNERS AND CHILDREN OF OWNERS, TRAINERS AND JOCKEYS, 3 other persons whose actual duties require their presence at such race-4 track, AND ANY OTHER PERSON OR GUEST DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY SUCH CORPO-5 RATION OR ASSOCIATION. IN ADDITION, FREE PASSES, CARDS OR BADGES MAY ΒE 6 ISSUED TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC IN CONNECTION WITH ANY PROMOTIONAL CAMPAIGN 7 MARKETING PROGRAM SPONSORED BY SUCH CORPORATION OR ASSOCIATION TO OR 8 INCREASE ATTENDANCE AT LIVE RACE MEETS. The issuance of free passes, 9 cards or badges shall be under the rules and regulations of the state 10 racing and wagering board [and a list of all persons to whom free passes, cards or badges are issued shall be filed with the state racing and 11 12 wagering board].

13 S 4. Section 422 of the racing, pari-mutuel wagering and breeding law 14 is amended to read as follows:

15 S 422. Free passes, cards or badges. A corporation or association 16 licensed to conduct pari-mutuel betting on quarter horse races run at 17 its racetrack [shall] MAY issue free passes, cards or badges to [persons 18 hereafter described:] ANY OUALIFIED PERSON. OUALIFIED PERSON SHALL 19 INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, officers and employees of the corporation or association conducting the race meeting, members, officers and 20 21 employees of the state racing and wagering board, members of quarter 22 horse racing associations of other states and foreign countries, public officers engaged in the performance of their duties, persons actually 23 24 employed and accredited by the press to attend such meetings, owners, 25 stable managers, trainers, jockeys, concessionaires [and], SPOUSES, 26 DOMESTIC PARTNERS AND CHILDREN OF OWNERS, TRAINERS AND JOCKEYS, other persons whose actual duties require their presence at such racetrack, 27 28 AND ANY OTHER PERSON OR GUEST DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY SUCH CORPORATION OR 29 ASSOCIATION. IN ADDITION, FREE PASSES, CARDS OR BADGES MAY BE ISSUED TO IN CONNECTION WITH ANY PROMOTIONAL CAMPAIGN OR 30 THE GENERAL PUBLIC MARKETING PROGRAM SPONSORED BY SUCH CORPORATION OR ASSOCIATION TO 31 INCREASE ATTENDANCE AT LIVE RACE MEETS. 32 The issuance of free passes, 33 cards or badges shall be under the rules and regulations of the state racing and wagering board [and a list of all persons to whom free pass-34 es, cards or badges are issued shall be filed with the state racing and 35 36 wagering board].

37 S 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
