AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to requiring at least one employee of any child day care facility to be trained and certified in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and first aid

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 390-a of the social services law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:

- 5. A. THE SITE PROVIDER OF A FAMILY DAY CARE HOME OR GROUP FAMILY DAY THAT AT LEAST ONE EMPLOYEE WHO HOLDS A VALID SHALL PROVIDE CERTIFICATION IN A COURSE OF STUDY IN FIRST AID KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS AND CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION, WITH AN EMPHASIS ON PROVIDING THAT AID TO CHILDREN, AS APPROVED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES, BE ON PREMISES DURING THE OPERATING HOURS OF SUCH FAMI-LY DAY CARE HOME OR GROUP FAMILY DAY CARE HOME.
- 10 THE SITE SUPERVISOR OF A SCHOOL-AGE CHILD CARE PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE THAT AT LEAST ONE EMPLOYEE WHO HOLDS A VALID CERTIFICATION IN A 11 12 STUDY IN FIRST AID KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS AND CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION, WITH AN EMPHASIS ON PROVIDING THAT AID 13 TO CHILDREN, AS 14 APPROVED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY 15 SERVICES, BE ON PREMISES DURING THE OPERATING HOURS OF SUCH SCHOOL-AGE CHILD CARE PROGRAM. 16
- C. THE DIRECTOR OF A CHILD DAY CARE CENTER SHALL PROVIDE THAT AT LEAST EMPLOYEE WHO HOLDS A VALID CERTIFICATION IN A COURSE OF STUDY IN 18 FIRST AID KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS AND CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION, 19 WITH AN EMPHASIS ON PROVIDING THAT AID TO CHILDREN, AS APPROVED BY THE 20 21 COMMISSIONER OF THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES, BE ON PREM-ISES DURING THE OPERATING HOURS OF SUCH CHILD DAY CARE CENTER.

S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after it shall have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediately the amendment, addition, and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the timely implementation of this act on its effective date is hereby authorized and directed to be made on or before such effective date.
