AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to automated external defibrillator requirements

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4656 of the public health law, as added by chapter 2 of the laws of 2004, is amended by adding a new subdivision 9 to read as follows:

- (A) EVERY ASSISTED LIVING FACILITY LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE SHALL HAVE ON THE PREMISES AT LEAST ONE AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLA-AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH (A) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION THREE 6 7 THOUSAND-B OF THIS CHAPTER, AND SHALL HAVE IN ATTENDANCE AT ALL TIMES AT LEAST ONE INDIVIDUAL PERFORMING EMPLOYMENT OR INDIVIDUAL ACTING AUTHORIZED VOLUNTEER WHO HOLDS A VALID CERTIFICATION OF COMPLETION OF A 9 COURSE IN THE STUDY OF THE OPERATION OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLA-10 AND A VALID CERTIFICATION OF THE COMPLETION OF A COURSE IN THE 11 TORS TRAINING OF CARDIOPULMONARY 12 RESUSCITATION PROVIDED BY A 13 RECOGNIZED ORGANIZATION OR ASSOCIATION. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROMUL-14 GATE REGULATIONS TO DETERMINE THEQUANTITY AND TYPE DEEMED TO ENSURE READY AND APPROPRIATE ACCESS FOR USE DURING EMERGEN-15 ADEOUATE 16 CIES TAKING INTO ACCOUNT THE SIZE AND OCCUPANCY OF EACH FACILITY AND ANY 17 OTHER MATTER DEEMED NECESSARY BY THE COMMISSIONER TO EFFECTUATE THE DUTY 18 PRESCRIBED BY THIS SUBDIVISION. SUCH REGULATIONS SHALL ALSO PROVIDE 19 A PHASE-IN SCHEDULE OF THE DUTY CREATED BY THIS SUBDIVISION.
- 20 (B) ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES AND STAFF PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH (A) OF 21 THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE DEEMED A "PUBLIC ACCESS DEFIBRILLATION PROVID-22 ER" AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH (C) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION THREE 23 THOUSAND-B OF THIS CHAPTER AND SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS AND 24 LIMITATION OF SUCH SECTION.

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7 8 (C) PURSUANT TO SECTIONS THREE THOUSAND-A AND THREE THOUSAND-B OF THIS CHAPTER, ANY PUBLIC ACCESS DEFIBRILLATION PROVIDER, OR ANY EMPLOYEE OR OTHER AGENT OF THE PROVIDER WHO, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, VOLUNTARILY AND WITHOUT EXPECTATION OF MONETARY COMPENSATION RENDERS EMERGENCY MEDICAL OR FIRST AID TREATMENT USING AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR WHICH HAS BEEN MADE AVAILABLE PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION, TO A PERSON WHO IS UNCONSCIOUS, ILL OR INJURED, SHALL BE LIABLE ONLY PURSUANT TO SECTION THREE THOUSAND-A OF THIS CHAPTER.
