AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to allowing the use of rifles for hunting in the county of Schuyler

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Item (i) of paragraph a of subdivision 2 of section 11-0907
2 of the environmental conservation law, as amended by section 1 of chap-
3 ter 412 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as follows:

18 section 3 of chapter 412 of the laws of 2008, as amended, when upon such
19 date the provisions of section two of this act shall take effect and
20 provided, further, that the amendments to item (i) of paragraph a of
21 subdivision 2 of section 11-0907 of the environmental conservation law
22 made by section two of this act shall not affect the expiration of such
23 item and shall be deemed to expire therewith.
