- AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to prohibiting idling by heavy-duty vehicles

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1205 to read as follows:

3 S 1205. PROHIBITIONS ON IDLING BY HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLES. 1. NOTWITH-STANDING ANY PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, NO PERSON WHO OWNS, OPER-4 5 ATES OR LEASES A HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLE INCLUDING A BUS OR TRUCK, THE MOTIVE б POWER FOR WHICH IS PROVIDED BY A DIESEL OR NON-DIESEL FUELED ENGINE OR 7 WHO OWNS, LEASES OR OCCUPIES LAND AND HAS THE ACTUAL OR APPARENT DOMIN-8 ION OR CONTROL OVER THE OPERATION OF A HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLE INCLUDING A BUS OR TRUCK PRESENT ON SUCH LAND, THE MOTIVE POWER FOR WHICH SAID HEAV-9 10 Y-DUTY VEHICLE IS PROVIDED BY A DIESEL OR NON-DIESEL FUELED ENGINE, 11 SHALL ALLOW OR PERMIT THE ENGINE OF SUCH HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLE TO IDLE FOR 12 MORE THAN ONE CONSECUTIVE MINUTE WHEN THE HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLE IS NOT IN 13 MOTION, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PERMITTED BY SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS SECTION. 14

15 2. THE PROHIBITIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY WHEN:

16 (A) A DIESEL OR NON-DIESEL FUELED HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLE INCLUDING A BUS 17 OR TRUCK IS FORCED TO REMAIN MOTIONLESS BECAUSE OF THE TRAFFIC CONDI-18 TIONS OVER WHICH THE OPERATOR THEREOF HAS NO CONTROL;

EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets
[] is old law to be omitted.

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1 (B) REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY FEDERAL, STATE OR LOCAL AGENCIES HAVING 2 JURISDICTION CONFLICT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS 3 SECTION, INCLUDING THOSE PERTAINING TO PASSENGER SAFETY, SECURITY AND 4 ACCESSIBILITY; IN SUCH CASE, THE IDLING TIME SPECIFIED IN SUBDIVISION 5 ONE OF THIS SECTION MAY BE INCREASED, BUT ONLY TO THE EXTENT NECESSARY 6 TO COMPLY WITH SUCH REGULATIONS.

7 (C) A DIESEL OR NON-DIESEL FUELED ENGINE IS BEING USED TO PROVIDE
8 POWER FOR AN AUXILIARY PURPOSE, SUCH AS LOADING, DISCHARGING, MIXING OR
9 PROCESSING CARGO, CONTROLLING CARGO TEMPERATURE, CONSTRUCTION, LUMBER10 ING, OIL OR GAS WELL SERVICING, FARMING, OR WHEN OPERATION OF THE ENGINE
11 IS REQUIRED FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAINTENANCE;

12 (D) IDLING OF THE PRIMARY PROPULSION ENGINE IS NECESSARY TO POWER 13 ESSENTIAL WORK-RELATED MECHANICAL OR ELECTRICAL OPERATIONS OTHER THAN 14 PROPULSION;

15 (E) FIRE, POLICE AND PUBLIC UTILITY TRUCKS OR OTHER VEHICLES ARE 16 PERFORMING EMERGENCY SERVICES;

17 (F) TRUCKS OWNED OR OPERATED BY PERSONS ENGAGED IN MINING AND QUARRY-18 ING ARE USED WITHIN THE CONFINES OF SUCH PERSON'S PROPERTY;

19 (G) A DIESEL FUELED TRUCK IS TO REMAIN MOTIONLESS FOR A PERIOD EXCEED-20 ING TWO HOURS, AND DURING WHICH PERIOD THE AMBIENT TEMPERATURE IS 21 CONTINUOUSLY BELOW TWENTY-FIVE DEGREES FAHRENHEIT;

(H) A HEAVY-DUTY DIESEL VEHICLE THAT IS QUEUED FOR OR IS UNDERGOING A
 STATE AUTHORIZED PERIODIC OR ROADSIDE DIESEL EMISSIONS INSPECTION;

24 (I) A HYBRID ELECTRIC VEHICLE, IDLING FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING 25 ENERGY FOR BATTERY OR OTHER FORM OF ENERGY STORAGE RECHARGING;

(J) HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLES USED FOR AGRICULTURAL PURPOSES ON A FARM;

(K) ELECTRIC POWERED VEHICLES; AND

(L) RECREATIONAL FACILITIES.

3. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY TO ALL ON-ROAD HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLES PROPELLED BY DIESEL FUELED AND NON-DIESEL FUELED ENGINES EXCLUDING MARINE VESSELS. AS USED IN THIS SECTION "HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLE" MEANS A VEHICLE THAT HAS A GVWR EXCEEDING EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS AND IS DESIGNED PRIMARILY FOR TRANSPORTING PERSONS OR PROPERTIES.

35 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
