AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to prohibiting idling by heavy-duty vehicles

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a 2 new section 19-0325 to read as follows:
 - S 19-0325. PROHIBITION ON IDLING BY HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLES.

- 4 1. NO PERSON SHALL ALLOW OR PERMIT THE IDLING OF A HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLE FOR MORE THAN THREE MINUTES EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY THE DEPART-6 MENT IN REGULATION.
 - 2. THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT AND UPDATE, FROM TIME TO TIME, REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION. THE REGULATIONS SHALL INCLUDE ANY EXEMPTIONS DEEMED BY THE DEPARTMENT TO BE NECESSARY OR APPROPRIATE.
- 13. AS USED IN THIS SECTION "HEAVY-DUTY VEHICLE" MEANS A VEHICLE THAT 12 HAS A GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING EXCEEDING EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS DESIGNED PRIMARILY FOR TRANSPORTING PERSONS OR PROPERTIES.
- 4. THE DEPARTMENT, IN COOPERATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHI15 CLES, SHALL CONDUCT OUTREACH AND PROVIDE EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS ON THE
