- AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to mandatory continuing education for massage therapists

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 7807 2 to read as follows:

3 S 7807. MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION. 1. (A) EACH MASSAGE THERAPIST 4 LICENSED PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE REQUIRED TO REGISTER TRIENNIALLY WITH 5 THE DEPARTMENT TO PRACTICE IN THE STATE SHALL COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS б OF THE MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED IN SUBDI-7 TWO OF THIS SECTION EXCEPT AS SET FORTH IN PARAGRAPHS (B) AND VISION 8 (C) OF THIS SUBDIVISION. MASSAGE THERAPISTS WHO DO NOT SATISFY THE 9 MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS SHALL NOT PRACTICE UNTIL THEY HAVE MET SUCH REQUIREMENTS, AND THEY HAVE BEEN ISSUED 10 A REGISTRA-CERTIFICATE, EXCEPT THAT A MASSAGE THERAPIST MAY PRACTICE WITHOUT 11 TION HAVING MET SUCH REQUIREMENTS IF HE OR SHE IS ISSUED A CONDITIONAL REGIS-12 13 TRATION CERTIFICATE PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION THREE OF THIS SECTION.

14 (B) MASSAGE THERAPISTS SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE MANDATORY CONTINUING 15 EDUCATION REQUIREMENT FOR THE TRIENNIAL REGISTRATION PERIOD DURING WHICH 16 THEY ARE FIRST LICENSED. IN ACCORD WITH THE INTENT OF THIS SECTION, ADJUSTMENTS TO THE MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENT 17 MAY BETHE DEPARTMENT FOR REASONS OF HEALTH CERTIFIED BY AN APPRO-18 GRANTED BY PRIATE HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL, FOR EXTENDED ACTIVE DUTY WITH THE ARMED 19 20 FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES, OR FOR OTHER GOOD CAUSE ACCEPTABLE ТО THE 21 DEPARTMENT WHICH MAY PREVENT COMPLIANCE.

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(C) A LICENSED MASSAGE THERAPIST NOT ENGAGED IN PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE, 1 AS DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT, SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE MANDATORY 2 CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENT UPON THE FILING OF A STATEMENT WITH THE 3 4 DEPARTMENT DECLARING SUCH STATUS. ANY LICENSEE WHO RETURNS TO THE PRAC-5 TICE OF MASSAGE THERAPY DURING THE TRIENNIAL REGISTRATION PERIOD SHALL NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT PRIOR TO REENTERING THE PROFESSION AND SHALL MEET 6 7 SUCH MANDATORY EDUCATION REOUIREMENTS AS SHALL BE PRESCRIBED BY REGU-8 LATIONS OF THE COMMISSIONER.

2. DURING EACH TRIENNIAL REGISTRATION PERIOD AN APPLICANT FOR REGIS-9 10 TRATION AS A MASSAGE THERAPIST SHALL COMPLETE A MINIMUM OF THIRTY-SIX HOURS OF ACCEPTABLE FORMAL CONTINUING EDUCATION, A MAXIMUM OF TWELVE 11 HOURS OF WHICH MAY BE SELF-INSTRUCTIONAL COURSE WORK ACCEPTABLE TO THE 12 DEPARTMENT. ANY MASSAGE THERAPIST WHOSE FIRST REGISTRATION DATE FOLLOW-13 14 ING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION OCCURS LESS THAN THREE YEARS FROM SUCH EFFECTIVE DATE, BUT ON OR AFTER JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN, 15 SHALL COMPLETE CONTINUING EDUCATION HOURS ON A PRORATED BASIS AT THE 16 RATE OF ONE-HALF HOUR PER MONTH FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY FIRST, 17 TWO THOUSAND ELEVEN UP TO THE FIRST REGISTRATION DATE THEREAFTER. A 18 19 LICENSEE WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS SHALL NOT BE ISSUED A TRIENNIAL REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE BY 20 21 THE DEPARTMENT AND SHALL NOT PRACTICE UNLESS AND UNTIL A CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED AS PROVIDED FOR IN SUBDIVISION THREE 22 OF THIS SECTION, OR UNTIL HE OR SHE HAS OTHERWISE MET THE REQUIREMENTS 23 24 OF THIS SECTION.

25 3. THE DEPARTMENT, IN ITS DISCRETION, MAY ISSUE A CONDITIONAL REGIS-TRATION TO A LICENSEE WHO FAILS TO MEET THE CONTINUING EDUCATION 26 REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED IN SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS SECTION BUT WHO 27 AGREES TO MAKE UP ANY DEFICIENCIES AND COMPLETE ANY ADDITIONAL EDUCATION 28 29 WHICH THE DEPARTMENT MAY REQUIRE. THE FEE FOR SUCH A CONDITIONAL REGIS-30 TRATION SHALL BE THE SAME AS, AND IN ADDITION TO, THE FEE FOR THE TRIEN-NIAL REGISTRATION. THE DURATION OF SUCH CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION SHALL 31 32 ΒE DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT BUT SHALL NOT EXCEED ONE YEAR. ANY 33 LICENSEE WHO IS NOTIFIED OF THE DENIAL OF REGISTRATION FOR FAILURE TO SUBMIT EVIDENCE, SATISFACTORY TO THE DEPARTMENT, OF REQUIRED CONTINUING 34 35 EDUCATION AND WHO PRACTICES WITHOUT SUCH REGISTRATION, MAY BE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS PURSUANT TO SECTION SIXTY-FIVE HUNDRED TEN OF 36 37 THIS CHAPTER.

38 4. AS USED IN SUBDIVISION TWO OF THIS SECTION, "ACCEPTABLE FORMAL CONTINUING EDUCATION" MAY MEAN FORMAL PROGRAMS OF LEARNING WHICH 39 40 CONTRIBUTE TO PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE IN MASSAGE THERAPY WHICH ARE OFFERED SPONSORS OF MASSAGE THERAPY CONTINUING EDUCATION APPROVED BY THE 41 BY DEPARTMENT IN CONSULTATION WITH THE STATE BOARD FOR MASSAGE THERAPY, TO 42 43 FULFILL THE MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENT. SPONSORS OF MASSAGE THERAPY CONTINUING EDUCATION MAY INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED 44 45 TO, STATE OR NATIONAL PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATIONS ESTABLISHED TO FURTHER THE MASSAGE THERAPY PROFESSION, AND MAY INCLUDE ANY AFFILIATES OF INTER-46 NATIONAL MASSAGE THERAPY CONFERENCES AT WHICH PROFESSIONAL CONTINUING 47 EDUCATION IS A MAJOR COMPONENT OF SUCH CONFERENCES, AS WELL AS UNIVERSI-48 49 TIES AND COLLEGES OFFERING PROGRAMS LEADING TO LICENSURE IN THE MASSAGE 50 THERAPY PROFESSION. SPONSORS OF MASSAGE THERAPY SHALL FILE AN APPLICA-TION WITH THE DEPARTMENT AND PAY A FEE OF NINE HUNDRED DOLLARS. 51

52 5. MASSAGE THERAPISTS SHALL MAINTAIN ADEQUATE DOCUMENTATION OF 53 COMPLETION OF ACCEPTABLE FORMAL CONTINUING EDUCATION AND SHALL PROVIDE 54 SUCH DOCUMENTATION AT THE REQUEST OF THE DEPARTMENT. FAILURE TO PROVIDE 55 SUCH DOCUMENTATION UPON THE REQUEST OF THE DEPARTMENT SHALL BE AN ACT OF

3 6. THE MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION FEE SHALL BE FORTY-FIVE DOLLARS, 4 SHALL BE PAYABLE ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF EACH TRIENNIAL REGISTRA-5 TION PERIOD, AND SHALL BE PAID IN ADDITION TO THE TRIENNIAL REGISTRATION 6 FEE REQUIRED BY SECTION SEVENTY-ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR OF THIS CHAPTER. S 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2011. Effective immediate-7 ly, any rules and regulations necessary to implement the provisions of 8 this act on its effective date are authorized to be promulgated, 9 10 repealed and/or amended before such effective date.
