THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraph f of subdivision 2 of section 5001 of the tion law, as amended by chapter 439 of the laws of 1980, is amended to read as follows:
- f. schools which provide instruction in the following subjects religion, dancing, music, painting, drawing, sculpture, poetry, dramatic art, languages, reading comprehension, mathematics, recreation, YOGA, MARTIAL ARTS and athletics, INCLUDING THE TRAINING OF STUDENTS TO TEACH 7 SUCH SUBJECTS;
 - S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
