- AN ACT to amend the civil rights law, in relation to authorizing funeral or bereavement leave for same-sex committed partners

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The civil rights law is amended by adding a new section 2 79-n to read as follows:

79-N. FUNERAL OR BEREAVEMENT LEAVE. NO EMPLOYER WHO EXTENDS TO ITS 3 S 4 EMPLOYEES FUNERAL OR BEREAVEMENT LEAVE FOR THE DEATH OF AN EMPLOYEE 'S 5 SPOUSE OR THE CHILD, PARENT OR OTHER RELATIVE OF THE SPOUSE SHALL DENY THE SAME LEAVE TO AN EMPLOYEE FOR THE DEATH OF THE EMPLOYEE'S 6 SAME-SEX 7 COMMITTED PARTNER OR THE CHILD, PARENT OR OTHER RELATIVE OF THE COMMIT-8 TED PARTNER. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, SAME-SEX COMMITTED PART-9 THOSE WHO ARE FINANCIALLY AND EMOTIONALLY INTERDEPENDENT IN A NERS ARE 10 MANNER COMMONLY PRESUMED OF SPOUSES.

11 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 12 have become a law.
