AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to school-based health centers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 2510 of the public health law is amended by adding
2 two new subdivisions 13 and 14 to read as follows:
3 13. "SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTER" MEANS A CLINIC LICENSED UNDER ARTICLE
4 TWENTY-EIGHT OF THIS CHAPTER, OR SPONSORED BY A FACILITY LICENSED UNDER
5 THIS CHAPTER, WHICH PROVIDES PRIMARY AND PREVENTIVE HEALTH SERVICES
6 WITHIN AN ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY PUBLIC SCHOOL SETTING.
7 14. "SPONSORING ORGANIZATION" MEANS A FACILITY LICENSED UNDER ARTICLE
8 TWENTY-EIGHT OF THIS CHAPTER WHICH ACTS AS THE SPONSOR FOR A
9 SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTER.
10 S 2. Subdivision 9 of section 2511 of the public health law, as
11 amended by chapter 639 of the laws of 1996, is amended to read as
12 follows:

EXPLANATION--Matter in *ITALICS* (underscored) is new; matter in brackets
[] is old law to be omitted.

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1 9. The commissioner shall, within amounts available therefor, contract
2 with community-based and other marketing organizations for purposes of
3 public education, outreach, and recruitment of eligible children,
4 including the distribution of applications and information regarding
5 enrollment. In awarding such contracts, the commissioner shall consider
6 the marketing, outreach and recruitment efforts of approved organiza-
7 tions, and the extent to which such organizations are able to effec-
8 tively target efforts in geographic regions where the proportion of
9 eligible children enrolled under this title are lower than in other
10 geographic regions of the state. Community-based organizations shall
11 include, but not be limited to: day care centers, schools, SCHOOL-BASED
12 HEALTH CENTERS, community-based diagnostic and treatment centers, and
13 hospitals.

14 S 3. Section 2511 of the public health law is amended by adding a new
15 subdivision 21 to read as follows:

16 21. AN APPROVED ORGANIZATION SHALL NOT LIMIT AN ELIGIBLE CHILD'S
17 DIRECT ACCESS TO PRIMARY AND PREVENTIVE HEALTH CARE SERVICES, DENTAL
18 SERVICES OR MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES COVERED PURSUANT TO THIS TITLE FROM A
19 SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTER SERVING THE SCHOOL ATTENDED BY THE CHILD WHEN
20 THE SPONSORING ORGANIZATION OF THE SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTER IS
21 INCLUDED IN THE PROVIDER NETWORK OF THE APPROVED ORGANIZATION IN WHICH
22 THE CHILD IS ENROLLED. THE SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTER SHALL COMMUNICATE
23 ANY SUCH PRIMARY CARE SERVICES AND TREATMENT PLAN WITH THE CHILD'S
24 PRIMARY CARE PRACTITIONER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE
25 ORGANIZATION AND THIS TITLE. AN APPROVED ORGANIZATION SHALL PROVIDE
26 LEVELS AND METHODS OF PAYMENT TO SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS CONSISTENT
27 WITH THOSE PROVIDED FOR SIMILAR SERVICES IN SIMILAR SETTINGS BY SIMILAR
28 PROVIDERS IN THE APPROVED ORGANIZATION'S NETWORK.

29 S 4. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
30 have become a law; provided, however, that the amendments to subdivision
31 9 of section 2511 of the public health law made by section two of this
32 act shall take effect pursuant to section 47 of chapter 2 of the laws of
33 1998, as amended.
