AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to state highways in the village of Medina, Orleans county

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 35 of section 341 of the highway law is amended
2 by adding two new paragraphs 3 and 4 to read as follows:

3 3. EFFECTIVE JULY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND TEN, THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE
4 VILLAGE OF MEDINA, HAVING PREVIOUSLY APPROVED THE EXCHANGE OF HIGHWAYS
5 DESCRIBED IN THIS PARAGRAPH, THE COMMISSIONER IS AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED
6 TO ASSUME JURISDICTION FOR STATE HIGHWAY PURPOSES OVER THE VILLAGE ROADS
7 DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: THE PORTION OF NEWLY ROUTED SIXTY-THREE, RESERVED
8 AS STATE HIGHWAY NINE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY-TWO, KNOWN AS NORTH
9 MAIN STREET, FROM THE INTERSECTION OF GLENWOOD AVENUE NORTHERLY TO WEST
10 AVENUE, AND THE PORTION OF NEWLY ROUTED SIXTY-THREE, ALSO RESERVED AS
11 STATE HIGHWAY NINE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY-TWO, KNOWN AS COMMERCIAL
12 STREET, FROM THE INTERSECTION OF WEST AVENUE NORTHERLY TO PROSPECT
13 AVENUE. AND TO ISSUE OFFICIAL ORDERS OF ABANDONMENT OF THOSE PORTIONS OF
14 HIGHWAYS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: THE PORTION OF STATE HIGHWAY FIVE THOU-
15 SAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTEEN PREVIOUSLY ROUTED NY SIXTY-THREE, KNOWN AS
16 WEST CENTER STREET, FROM THE INTERSECTION OF PROSPECT AVENUE EASTERLY TO
17 THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH AND SOUTH MAIN STREETS; A PORTION OF STATE
18 HIGHWAY FIVE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTEEN PREVIOUSLY ROUTED NY SIXTY-
19 THREE, KNOWN AS PROSPECT AVENUE, FROM WEST CENTER STREET NORTHERLY TO
20 COMMERCIAL STREET.

21 4. UPON THE FILING OF CERTIFIED COPIES OF SUCH OFFICIAL ORDER WITH THE
22 VILLAGE CLERK, SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, COUNTY CLERK, THE COUNTY
23 TREASURER, THE CLERK OF THE LEGISLATIVE BODY, THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT
24 OF HIGHWAYS, AND THE STATE COMPTROLLER, THE STATE SHALL CEASE TO MAIN-
25 TAIN THE AFORESAID HIGHWAYS SPECIFIED FOR ABANDONMENT AS SET FORTH IN
26 PARAGRAPH THREE OF THIS SUBDIVISION AND ALL THE RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS
27 OF THE STATE THEREIN SHALL BE TURNED OVER AND SURRENDERED TO THE VILLAGE
28 OF MEDINA AND SAID STATE HIGHWAY SHALL THEREAFTER BE MAINTAINED BY SAID
29 VILLAGE AS A PART OF THE VILLAGE ROAD SYSTEM OF SAID VILLAGE.

30 S 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
