AN ACT to amend the family court act, in relation to orders of disposition

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 352.2 of the family court act, added by chapter 920 of the laws of 1982, is amended to read as follows:

- (A) Upon the conclusion of the dispositional hearing, the court shall enter an order of disposition:
- 5 [(a)] (I) conditionally discharging the respondent in accord with 6 section 353.1; or
 - [(b)] (II) putting the respondent on probation in accord with section 353.2; or
 - [(c)] (III) continuing the proceeding and placing the respondent in accord with section 353.3; or
 - [(d)] (IV) placing the respondent in accord with section 353.4; or
 - [(e)] (V) continuing the proceeding and placing the respondent under a restrictive placement in accord with section 353.5.
- THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS SUBDIVI-NOTWITHSTANDING SION, THE COURT SHALL NOT PLACE A RESPONDENT IN THE CUSTODY OF THE COMMISSIONER OF THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES PURSUANT TO EITHER SUBPARAGRAPHS (III) OR (IV) OF PARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS SUBDIVISION THECOURT DETERMINES THAT(I) CONDITIONAL DISCHARGE OF THE RESPONDENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 351.1 WOULD NOT BE APPROPRIATE; AND (II) SUCH RESPONDENT POSES A SIGNIFICANT RISK TO PUBLIC SAFETY AND THAT NO AVAILABLE ALTERNATIVES TO PLACEMENT COULD ADEQUATELY MITIGATE THE COURT SHALL NOTIFY THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES RISK. 23 OF SUCH DETERMINATION.
- S 2. Subdivision 3 of section 352.2 of the family court act, as added 24 25 by chapter 920 of the laws of 1982, is amended to read as follows:
- 26 3. The order shall state the court's reasons for the particular disposition, including[,]: 27

(A) in the case of a restrictive placement pursuant to section 353.5, the specific findings of fact required in such section[.]; AND

- (B) IN THE CASE OF PLACEMENT OF THE RESPONDENT IN THE CUSTODY OF THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES EITHER PURSUANT TO SECTION 353.3 OR 353.4, THE SPECIFIC FINDINGS OF FACT REQUIRED BY PARAGRAPH (B) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION.
