AN ACT to repeal chapter 241 of the laws of 1930 relating to the New York Board of Fire Underwriters, relating to the elimination of such board; and to repeal chapter 181 of the laws of 1939 amending chapter 241 of the laws of 1930 relating to the amount and assessment of expenses of the fire patrol, relating to the elimination of such board

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter 241 of the laws of 1930 relating to the New York 2 Board of Fire Underwriters, is REPEALED.
 - S 2. Chapter 181 of the laws of 1939 amending chapter 241 of the laws of 1930 relating to the amount and assessment of expenses of the fire patrol, is REPEALED.
 - S 3. Any assets held by the New York Board of Fire Underwriters at the time of the effective date of this act shall inure to the benefit of the state of New York and may be devoted to the electrical inspection pilot program contained in section four of this act in the manner and amount deemed appropriate.
- 11 S 4. The secretary of state's office of fire prevention and control is 12 hereby authorized to conduct an electrical inspection pilot program in 13 coordination with municipalities, or any other public or private enti-14 ties as deemed appropriate by such office. Such entity shall be known as 15 the Electrical Bureau of State Fire.
- 16 S 5. This act shall take effect April 1, 2011.
