AN ACT to amend chapter 118 of the laws of 1969, relating to a separate union free school district in the town of Greenburgh in the county of Westchester, in relation to clarifying the authority of the Greenburgh North Castle Union Free School District to lease certain properties located outside of its boundaries

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     Section 1. Chapter 118 of the laws of 1969, relating to a separate  
2 union free school district in the town of Greenburgh in the county of  
3 Westchester is amended by adding a new section 2-a to read as follows:  
4     S 2-A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, RULE, OR REGULATION TO THE  
5 CONTRARY, IN ADDITION TO THE POWERS GRANTED BY SECTION TWO OF THIS ACT,  
6 SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE NEW YORK STATE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT, THE  
7 BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL BE AUTHORIZED TO LEASE PROPERTIES LOCATED AT  
8 623 BLOOMING GROVE TURNPIKE, IN THE TOWN OF NEW WINDSOR, COUNTY OF  
9 ORANGE AND AT 24 MAPLE AVENUE, IN THE CITY OF NEW ROCHELLE, COUNTY OF  
10 WESTCHESTER FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING INSTRUCTION TO STUDENTS  
11 ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT.  
12     S 2. The actions of the board of education of the Greenburgh North  
13 Castle Union Free School District in entering a lease of properties  
14 located at 623 Blooming Grove Turnpike, in the town of New Windsor,  
15 county of Orange and at 24 Maple Avenue, in the city of New Rochelle,  
16 county of Westchester prior to the effective date of this act are hereby  
17 ratified, validated and confirmed notwithstanding its location outside  
18 of the school district boundaries.  
19     S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
