AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to permitting the holder of a wholesaler's license to install and operate a single automated teller machine

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 104 of the alcoholic beverage 2 control law is amended by adding a new paragraph (a-1) to read as 3 follows:
- INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF A SINGLE AUTOMATED TELLER (A-1) $_{
  m THE}$ SHALL NOT CONSTITUTE MACHINE AT EACH LICENSED PREMISES ENGAGING 6 ANOTHER BUSINESS THE MEANING OF THIS FOR THE WITHIN SUBDIVISION. 7 PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION, "AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINE" MEANS A DEVICE 8 WHICH IS LINKED TO THE ACCOUNTS AND RECORDS OF A BANKING INSTITUTION AND WHICH ENABLES CONSUMERS TO CARRY OUT BANKING TRANSACTIONS, INCLUDING, 9 BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ACCOUNT TRANSFERS, DEPOSITS, CASH WITHDRAWALS, 10 BALANCE INQUIRIES, AND LOAN PAYMENTS. 11
- 12 S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 13 have become a law. Effective immediately the addition, amendment, and/or 14 repeal of any rule or regulation necessary for the timely implementation 15 of this act on its effective date is hereby authorized to be made on or 16 before such date.
