- AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to temporary preinvestigation grants

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 133 of the social services law is amended to read 2 as follows:

3 S 133. Temporary preinvestigation [grant] EMERGENCY NEEDS ASSISTANCE 4 UPON APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC ASSISTANCE OR CARE UNDER THIS CARE. OR 5 CHAPTER, THE LOCAL SOCIAL SERVICES DISTRICT SHALL NOTIFY THE APPLICANT 6 IN WRITING OF THE AVAILABILITY OF A MONETARY GRANT ADEQUATE TO MEET EMERGENCY NEEDS ASSISTANCE OR CARE AND SHALL, AT SUCH TIME, 7 DETERMINE WHETHER SUCH PERSON IS IN IMMEDIATE NEED. If it shall appear that a 8 9 person is in immediate need, [temporary assistance or care] EMERGENCY NEEDS ASSISTANCE OR CARE shall be granted pending completion of an 10 11 investigation. THE WRITTEN NOTIFICATION REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION SHALL INFORM SUCH PERSON OF A RIGHT TO AN EXPEDITED HEARING WHEN EMERGENCY 12 NEEDS ASSISTANCE OR CARE IS DENIED. A PUBLIC ASSISTANCE 13 APPLICANT WHO HAS BEEN DENIED EMERGENCY NEEDS ASSISTANCE OR CARE MUST BE GIVEN REASON 14 15 FOR SUCH DENIAL IN A WRITTEN DETERMINATION WHICH SETS FORTH THE BASIS 16 FOR SUCH DENIAL.
