AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to notice and expedited re-application in cases of the termination of medical assistance eligibility

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 8 of section 22 of the social services law, as added by chapter 473 of the laws of 1978, is amended to read as follows:

- 8. The department shall promulgate such regulations, not inconsistent with federal or state law, as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this section. Such regulations shall require that a copy of all decisions made concerning appeals pursuant to this section shall
- 7 be sent to each party to such appeals and their representatives, if any. 8 SUCH REGULATIONS SHALL ALSO REQUIRE THAT PERSONS WHOSE ELIGIBILITY FOR
- 9 MEDICAL ASSISTANCE IS TERMINATED BE NOTIFIED IN WRITING OF THE EFFECTIVE
- 10 DATE OF SUCH TERMINATION AND BE PROVIDED WITH INFORMATION ON THEIR RIGHT
- 11 TO AN APPEAL AND HOW TO UNDERTAKE SUCH PROCESS. THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL 12 HAVE AT LEAST THIRTY DAYS TO NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT OF THEIR INTENT TO
- 13 APPEAL THE DETERMINATION BEFORE ENROLLMENT IS TERMINATED; PROVIDED THAT
- 13 APPEAU THE DETERMINATION BEFORE ENROLLMENT IS TERMINATED, FROVIDED THAT 14 IN AN INSTANCE WHERE A PERSON HAS BEEN FOUND GUILTY OF FRAUD, SUCH THIR-
- 15 TY DAY TIME PERIOD SHALL NOT APPLY.
