AN ACT to amend the state finance law, in relation to background checks in connection with certain contracts

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 10 of section 163 of the state finance law, is amended by adding a new paragraph g to read as follows:

FOR SERVICES, THE COMMISSIONER OR STATE AGENCY MAY 3 IN CONTRACTS G. INCLUDE IN THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, A REQUIREMENT THAT PERSONS 4 EMPLOYED 5 THE CONTRACTOR TO PERFORM WORK PURSUANT TO THE CONTRACT SHALL BE ΒY б REQUIRED TO UNDERGO A STATE AND NATIONAL CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECK. 7 WHEN REQUIRED, THE FINGERPRINTS OF SUCH AN EMPLOYEE SHALL BE SUBMITTED 8 TO THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES AND THE DIVISION OF CRIMI-9 JUSTICE SERVICES IS AUTHORIZED TO SUBMIT SUCH FINGERPRINTS TO THE NAL FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPLICABLE RULES 10 OR REGULATIONS, IN ORDER TO OBTAIN RELEVANT STATE CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD 11 INFORMATION, IF ANY, CONCERNING SUCH EMPLOYEE, AND FOR A NATIONAL CRIMI-12 13 NAL HISTORY RECORD CHECK. THECONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR 14 INFORMING ITS EMPLOYEES THAT SUCH CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECKS MAY BE CONDUCTED. IN DETERMINING WHETHER TO INCLUDE SUCH REQUIREMENT 15 IN THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, THE COMMISSIONER OR STATE AGENCY SHALL CONSIDER, BUT 16 17 NOT BE LIMITED TO, WHETHER THE CONTRACTOR'S EMPLOYEES WILL COME INTO CONTACT WITH CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION IN THE COURSE OF PERFORMING 18 THE A TYPE THAT, IF PERFORMED BY 19 CONTRACT, AND WHETHER THE WORK IS OF 20 EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE, APPLICANTS FOR EMPLOYMENT WOULD BE REOUIRED BY SUBMIT TO A CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECK PURSUANT TO 21 THE STATE ΤO SECTION FIFTY OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW OR ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAW. 22 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 23 24 it shall have become a law; provided, however, that the amendments to 25 subdivision 10 of section 163 of the state finance law made by section one of this act shall not affect the repeal of such section and shall be 26
