AN ACT to amend the domestic relations law, in relation to no fault divorce

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- l Section 1. Section 170 of the domestic relations law is amended by adding a new subdivision 7 to read as follows:
 - (7) THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN HUSBAND AND WIFE HAS BROKEN DOWN IRRE-TRIEVABLY FOR A PERIOD OF AT LEAST SIX MONTHS, PROVIDED THAT ONESTATED UNDER OATH. EXCEPT UNDER EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES PLACED ON THE RECORD BY THE COURT, NO JUDGMENT OF DIVORCE SHALL BE GRANTED THIS SUBDIVISION UNLESS AND UNTIL THE ECONOMIC ISSUES OF EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION OF MARITAL PROPERTY, OR WAIVER OF THEPAYMENT THE PAYMENT OF COUNSEL AND SUPPORT, THEPAYMENT OF CHILD SUPPORT, EXPERTS' FEES AND EXPENSES AS WELL AS THE CUSTODY AND VISITATION INFANT CHILDREN OF THE MARRIAGE HAVE BEEN RESOLVED BY THE PARTIES,
- 11 THE INFANT CHILDREN OF THE MARRIAGE HAVE BEEN RESOLVED BY THE PARTIES, 12 OR DETERMINED BY THE COURT AND INCORPORATED INTO THE JUDGMENT OF
- 13 DIVORCE.
