AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to reporting on motor vehicle insurance fraud

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraph 11 of subsection (d) of section 405 of the insurance law, as amended by chapter 499 of the laws of 2009, is amended to read as follows:
 - (11) an assessment of law enforcement and insurance company activities to detect and curtail the incidence of operating a motor vehicle without proper insurance coverage as required by this chapter AND THE INCIDENCE OF MISREPRESENTATION BY INSUREDS OF THE PRINCIPAL PLACE WHERE MOTOR VEHICLES ARE GARAGED AND DRIVEN.
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 10 it shall have become a law.
