AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law and the state finance law, in relation to creating the "stop prostate cancer" distinctive license plate program and applying the revenues raised from the new program to the purposes of the prostate and testicular cancer research and education fund

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 404-x to read as follows:

3 S 404-X. DISTINCTIVE "STOP PROSTATE CANCER" LICENSE PLATES. 1. ANY 4 PERSON RESIDING IN THIS STATE SHALL, UPON REQUEST, BE ISSUED A DISTINC-5 PROSTATE CANCER" LICENSE PLATE IN SUPPORT OF PROSTATE AND TIVE "STOP б TESTICULAR CANCER RESEARCH BEARING THE PHRASE "STOP PROSTATE CANCER". 7 APPLICATION FOR SAID LICENSE PLATE SHALL BE FILED WITH THE COMMISSIONER 8 IN SUCH FORM AND DETAIL AS THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PRESCRIBE.

9 2. A DISTINCTIVE PLATE ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL BE ISSUED 10 IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER NUMBER PLATES UPON THE PAYMENT OF THE REGU-11 LAR REGISTRATION FEE PRESCRIBED BY SECTION FOUR HUNDRED ONE OF THIS ARTICLE; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT AN ADDITIONAL ANNUAL SERVICE CHARGE 12 OF 13 TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS SHALL BE CHARGED FOR SUCH PLATES. TWENTY DOLLARS 14 FROM EACH TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS RECEIVED AS THE ANNUAL SERVICE CHARGE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED TO THE CREDIT OF THE "PROSTATE AND 15 16 TESTICULAR CANCER RESEARCH AND EDUCATION FUND" ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO SECTION NINETY-SEVEN-CCC OF THE STATE FINANCE LAW AND SHALL BE USED FOR 17 PURPOSES OF SUCH FUND; AND PROVIDED FURTHER, HOWEVER, THAT ONE YEAR 18 THE AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION, FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT 19 OF SEVEN 20 THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS, OR SO MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE AVAILABLE, 21 SHALL BE ALLOCATED TO THE DEPARTMENT TO OFFSET COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE 22 PRODUCTION OF SUCH LICENSE PLATES.

S 97-ccc. Prostate and testicular cancer research and education fund. I. There is hereby established in the joint custody of the commissioner of taxation and finance and the comptroller, a special fund to be known as the "prostate and testicular cancer research and education fund".

8 2. Such fund shall consist of ALL REVENUES RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THE9 PROVISIONS OF SECTION FOUR HUNDRED FOUR-X OF THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC 10 LAW, all revenues received pursuant to an appropriation by the legislature, all moneys collected pursuant to section four hundred four-q of 11 12 the vehicle and traffic law, AS ADDED BY CHAPTER FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY-EIGHT OF THE LAWS OF NINETEEN HUNDRED NINETY-NINE, and all other 13 14 moneys appropriated, credited, or transferred thereto from any other fund or source pursuant to law. Nothing contained herein shall prevent 15 the state from receiving grants, gifts, or bequests for the purposes of 16 17 fund as defined in this section and depositing them into the fund the 18 according to law.

19 3. Monies of the fund shall be expended only for prostate and testicu-20 lar cancer research and educational projects. As used in this section, 21 "prostate and testicular cancer research and education projects" means 22 scientific research or educational projects which are approved by the 23 department of health and shall include but not be limited to:

(a) SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH OR EDUCATIONAL PROJECTS INTO THE CAUSES,
TREATMENT, AND PREVENTION OF PROSTATE AND TESTICULAR CANCER UPON THE
RECOMMENDATION OF THE HEALTH RESEARCH SCIENCE BOARD PURSUANT TO SECTION
TWENTY-FOUR HUNDRED ELEVEN OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW;

(B) establishment of a public education and outreach campaign to publicize prostate and testicular cancer detection and education services, including the extent of coverage for such services by health insurance, the medical assistance program, and other public and private programs;

33 [(b)] (C) compilation of data concerning the prostate and testicular 34 cancer detection and education program and dissemination of the data to 35 the public;

36 [(c)] (D) development of professional education programs, including 37 the benefits of early detection of prostate and testicular cancer and 38 the recommended frequency of the test and examination therefor; and

the recommended frequency of the test and examination therefor; and [(d)] (E) to further the goals and duties of the prostate and testicular cancer detection and education advisory council established in section twenty-four hundred fifteen of the public health law.

42 4. Monies shall be payable from the fund on the audit and warrant of 43 the comptroller on vouchers approved and certified by the commissioner 44 of health.

5. To the extent practicable, the commissioner of health shall ensure that all monies received during a fiscal year are expended prior to the end of that fiscal year.

S 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after it shall have become a law, provided, however, that effective immediately, the addition, amendment, or repeal of any rules or regulations necessary for the implementation of the foregoing sections of this act on its effective date is authorized and directed to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
