AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to the sale of tires

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 35 of section 375 of the vehicle and traffic 2 law is amended by adding a new paragraph (d) to read as follows:
  - (D) (I) NO TIRE SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED, SOLD OR OFFERED FOR SALE IN THIS STATE IF SUCH TIRE IS MORE THAN SIX YEARS OLD.
- 5 (II) WHENEVER THERE SHALL BE A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION, APPLICATION MAY BE MADE BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL IN THE NAME OF THE PEOPLE OF STATE OF NEW YORK TO A COURT OR JUSTICE HAVING JURISDICTION BY A SPECIAL 7 8 ISSUE AN INJUNCTION AND UPON NOTICE TO THE DEFENDANT OF PROCEEDING TO 9 NOT LESS THAN FIVE DAYS, TO ENJOIN AND RESTRAIN THE CONTINUANCE OF VIOLATION OR TO ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION; AND IF IT SHALL 10 APPEAR TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE COURT OR JUSTICE THAT THE 11 DEFENDANT HAS, IN FACT, VIOLATED THIS SECTION, AN INJUNCTION MAY BE ISSUED BY SUCH 12 COURT OR JUSTICE, ENJOINING AND RESTRAINING ANY FURTHER VIOLATION, WITH-13 14 REOUIRING PROOF THAT ANY PERSON HAS, IN FACT, BEEN INJURED OR DAMAGED THEREBY. WHENEVER THE COURT SHALL DETERMINE THAT A VIOLATION OF 15 OCCURRED THE COURT MAY IMPOSE A CIVIL PENALTY OF NOT 16 THIS SECTION HAS 17 MORE THAN FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR EACH VIOLATION. IN CONNECTION SUCH PROPOSED APPLICATION, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL IS AUTHORIZED TO 18 ANY
- 19 TAKE PROOF AND MAKE A DETERMINATION OF THE RELEVANT FACTS AND ISSUE 20 SUBPOENAS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CIVIL PRACTICE LAW AND RULES.
- 21 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 22 have become a law.
