- AN ACT to amend the real property actions and proceedings law, in relation to the abatement of rent where the landlord fails to make repairs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The real property actions and proceedings law is amended by 2 adding a new section 757 to read as follows:

3 S 757. RENT ABATEMENT FOR FAILURE TO MAKE 1. UPON PROPER REPAIRS. 4 PROOF OF THE EXISTENCE OF A CONDITION THAT IS, IN THE OPINION OF THE 5 COURT, SUCH AS TO CONSTRUCTIVELY EVICT THE TENANT FROM A PORTION OF THE 6 OCCUPIED BY HIM OR HER, THE COURT SHALL STAY ANY PROCEEDING OR PREMISES 7 ACTION FOR RENT AND SHALL REDUCE ANY RENT DUE BY A FULL DAY'S RENT FOR 8 EACH DAY THE CONDITION IS NOT REPAIRED.

9 2. IF, IN THE OPINION OF THE COURT, THERE HAS BEEN PROPER PROOF OF THE 10 EXISTENCE OF A CONDITION WHICH REDUCES THE HABITABILITY OF THE PREMISES, COURT SHALL STAY ANY PROCEEDING OR ACTION FOR RENT AND SHALL REDUCE 11 THE ANY RENT DUE BY A PERCENTAGE RANGING FROM TEN TO FIFTY PERCENT, REPRES-12 IN THE OPINION OF THE COURT, THE REDUCTION OF HABITABILITY 13 ENTING, CAUSED BY THE CONDITIONS IN NEED OF REPAIR, FOR EACH DAY THE CONDITION 14 15 IS NOT REPAIRED.

16 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-17 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
