AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to affidavit ballots

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The election law is amended by adding a new section 8-318 2 to read as follows:
- 3 S 8-318. AFFIDAVIT BALLOTS. THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS SHALL ESTAB-4 LISH REASONABLE PROCEDURES TO ASSURE THE TIMELY PROCESSING AND COUNTING 5 OF AFFIDAVIT BALLOTS, INCLUDING:
- 1. STANDARDS FOR TIMELY PROCESSING AND COUNTING TO ASSURE THAT, AFTER THE CONCLUSION OF THE AFFIDAVIT VOTE COUNT, PARTIES AND CANDIDATES MAY HAVE FULL, TIMELY, AND EFFECTIVE RECOURSE TO THE RECOUNT AND CONTEST PROCEDURES; AND
- 2. STANDARDS FOR THE INFORMED PARTICIPATION OF CANDIDATES AND PARTIES SUCH AS ARE CONSISTENT WITH REASONABLE PROCEDURES TO PROTECT THE SECURITY, CONFIDENTIALITY, AND INTEGRITY OF PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTED IN
- 13 THE COURSE OF THE PROCESSING AND COUNTING OF AFFIDAVIT BALLOTS.
- 14 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
