AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to defining "tuition" for the 2013-2014 school year

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 4405 of the education law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph j to read as follows:

- J. THE TUITION RATE METHODOLOGY ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO THIS SION FOR SPECIAL ACT SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND APPROVED PRIVATE SCHOOLS FOR STUDENTS OF SCHOOL AGE FOR THE TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN--TWO THOUSAND FOUR-TEEN TUITION RATE YEAR AND THEREAFTER MAY INCLUDE A SURPLUS FACTOR, DISCRETION OF THE COMMISSIONER AND APPROVED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE BUDGET, WHICH SHALL EQUAL THE LESSER OF: (I) THE SUM OF: (A) THE EXCESS, IF ANY, OF THE TUITION REVENUE COMPUTED FOR THE BASE YEAR AND USED TUITION RATE FOR THE TUITION RATE YEAR OVER THE ALLOW-DETERMINING THE ABLE AND REIMBURSABLE COSTS INCURRED BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR PRIVATE BASE YEAR, NET OF ANY DISALLOWANCES, PLUS (B) ANY UNEX-SCHOOL IN THE PENDED SURPLUS AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR PRIOR TO THE BASE YEAR, AND (II) FOUR PERCENT OF THE TOTAL GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES UNDER THE BUDGET OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR APPROVED PRIVATE THE BASE YEAR. AS USED IN THIS SUBDIVISION, "TUITION RATE SCHOOL FOR YEAR" SHALL MEAN THE SCHOOL YEAR FOR WHICH A TUITION RATE IS SCHOOL YEAR TWO YEARS PRIOR TO THE "BASE YEAR" SHALL MEAN THEAND TUITION RATE YEAR. THE SPECIAL ACT SCHOOL DISTRICT OR APPROVED PRIVATE SCHOOL MAY RETAIN ANY SURPLUS COMPUTED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION AS
