AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to sale of products complementary to wine and wine products

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 63 of the alcoholic beverage 2 control law, as amended by chapter 603 of the laws of 1992, is amended 3 to read as follows:

4 4. No licensee under this section shall be engaged in any other business on the licensed premises. The sale of lottery tickets, when duly 5 б authorized and lawfully conducted, the sale of corkscrews or the sale of 7 ice or the sale of publications, including prerecorded video and/or audio cassette tapes, designed to help educate consumers in their know-8 9 ledge and appreciation of wine and wine products, as defined in section three of this chapter, or the sale of non-carbonated, non-flavored 10 mineral waters, spring waters and drinking waters or the sale of glasses 11 designed for the consumption of wine, racks designed for the storage of 12 wine, [and] devices designed to minimize oxidation in bottles 13 of wine 14 which have been uncorked, AND PRODUCTS COMPLEMENTARY TO WINE INCLUDING 15 CHOCOLATES, BAKERY PRODUCTS, PERISHABLE CHEESES AND FRUITS shall not 16 constitute engaging in another business within the meaning of this 17 subdivision. CHOCOLATES, BAKERY PRODUCTS, PERISHABLE CHEESES AND FRUITS COMPLEMENTARY TO WINE SHALL NOT BE SOLD EXCEPT WHEN SUCH AGGREGATE 18 SALE INCLUDES ONE OR MORE BOTTLES OF WINE. 19
