AN ACT in relation to allowing Marion Hoffman to file a request for Tier I status in the New York state and local police and fire retirement system with the state comptroller

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any inconsistent provisions of law, Marion Hoffman, a retired member of the New York state and local police and fire retirement system who was employed with the New York state department of environmental conservation as an environmental conservation officer for approximately thirty-six years and who, for reasons not ascribable to her own negligence, did not become a member of the New York state and local police and fire retirement system, at the time of her hiring, shall be deemed to have become a member of such system as of 9 June 14, 1973 entitling her to Tier I status with every right, benefit 10 and privilege which would have been available to her on such date.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 11
