AN ACT to amend the elder law, in relation to authorizing a pooled purchasing program for certain services and commodities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 203 of the elder law is amended by adding a new subdivision 11 to read as follows:
  - 11. IN ADDITION TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES CONTAINED IN SECTION TWO HUNDRED TWO OF THIS TITLE, THE OFFICE IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO ESTABLISH,
- 5 OPERATE, COORDINATE, ENCOURAGE THE DEVELOPMENT OF, AND/OR MAINTAIN, OR 6 TO CONTRACT WITH OTHER NOT-FOR-PROFIT OR FOR-PROFIT OR PUBLIC ENTITIES 7 ON BEHALF OF THOSE ENTITIES, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES FOR THE AGING OVER
- 7 ON BEHALF OF THOSE ENTITIES, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES FOR THE AGING OVER 8 WHICH IT HAS JURISDICTION, OVERSIGHT, OR OTHER CONTRACTUAL RELATIONSHIP,
- 9 FOR THE OPERATION OF A POOLED PURCHASING PROGRAM FOR CERTAIN SERVICES
- 10 AND COMMODITIES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, LIABILITY AND MOTOR
- 11 VEHICLE INSURANCE, AS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE OFFICE AFTER CONSULTA-
- 12 TION WITH THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE AGING AND OTHERS. THE OFFICE 13 SHALL ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE OPERATION OF SUCH POOLED
- 14 PURCHASING PROGRAMS IN WHICH IT IS INVOLVED.
- 15 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
