AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to prohibited basis for refusal to issue or renew a covered policy of property/casualty insurance or for limiting coverage therein

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 3425 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new subsection (i-1) to read as follows:
- (I-1) NO INSURER SHALL REFUSE TO ISSUE OR RENEW A COVERED POLICY, OR INCLUDE A PROVISION IN THE INSURANCE CONTRACT LIMITING COVERAGE UNDER THE CONTRACT, SOLELY ON THE GROUND OF THE NATURE OF THE OCCUPATION OF THE APPLICANT OR INSURED.
- 7 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of the calendar month 8 next succeeding the thirtieth day after it shall have become a law.
