AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to providing a tax exemption on real property owned by members of volunteer fire companies or voluntary ambulance services in certain counties and municipal corporations therein

PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-THE BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

The real property tax law is amended by adding a new 1 Section 1. section 466-k to read as follows:

3 466-к. VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS AND VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE WORKERS; S 4 CERTAIN COUNTIES. 1. REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY AN ENROLLED MEMBER OF AN 5 INCORPORATED VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY, FIRE DEPARTMENT OR INCORPORATED б VOLUNTARY AMBULANCE SERVICE OR SUCH ENROLLED MEMBER AND SPOUSE RESIDING 7 ANY COUNTY HAVING A POPULATION OF MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOU-INSAND BUT LESS THAN ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE THOUSAND AS DETERMINED 8 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LATEST DECENNIAL CENSUS, SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM TAXA-9 10 TION TO THE EXTENT OF TEN PERCENT OF THE ASSESSED VALUE OF SUCH PROPERTY FOR CITY, VILLAGE, TOWN, PART TOWN, SCHOOL DISTRICT, 11 SPECIAL DISTRICT, 12 COUNTY PURPOSES, EXCLUSIVE OF SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS, PROVIDED THAT THE OR GOVERNING BODY OF A CITY, VILLAGE, TOWN, SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR COUNTY, 13 AFTER A PUBLIC HEARING, ADOPTS A LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION 14 15 PROVIDING THEREFOR, PROVIDED FURTHER, HOWEVER, THAT SUCH EXEMPTION SHALL IN NO EVENT EXCEED THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS MULTIPLIED BY THE LATEST STATE 16 17 EQUALIZATION RATE FOR THE ASSESSING UNIT IN WHICH SUCH REAL PROPERTY IS 18 LOCATED.

SUCH 19 2. SHALL NOT BE GRANTED TO AN ENROLLED MEMBER OF AN EXEMPTION 20 INCORPORATED VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY, FIRE DEPARTMENT OR INCORPORATED 21 VOLUNTARY AMBULANCE SERVICE RESIDING IN SUCH COUNTY UNLESS:

1 (A) THE APPLICANT RESIDES IN THE CITY, TOWN, OR VILLAGE WHICH IS 2 SERVED BY SUCH INCORPORATED VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY OR FIRE DEPARTMENT OR 3 INCORPORATED VOLUNTARY AMBULANCE SERVICE;

(B) THE PROPERTY IS THE PRIMARY RESIDENCE OF THE APPLICANT;

5 (C) THE PROPERTY IS USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES; 6 PROVIDED HOWEVER, THAT IN THE EVENT ANY PORTION OF SUCH PROPERTY IS NOT 7 USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE APPLICANT'S RESIDENCE BUT IS USED FOR OTHER 8 PURPOSES, SUCH PORTION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO TAXATION AND THE REMAINING 9 PORTION ONLY SHALL BE ENTITLED TO THE EXEMPTION PROVIDED BY THIS 10 SECTION; AND

(D) THE APPLICANT HAS BEEN CERTIFIED BY THE AUTHORITY HAVING JURISDIC-11 TION FOR THE INCORPORATED VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY OR FIRE DEPARTMENT AS 12 AN ENROLLED MEMBER OF SUCH INCORPORATED VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY OR FIRE 13 DEPARTMENT FOR AT LEAST FIVE YEARS OR THE APPLICANT HAS BEEN CERTIFIED 14 THE AUTHORITY HAVING JURISDICTION FOR THE INCORPORATED VOLUNTARY 15 ΒY AMBULANCE SERVICE AS AN ENROLLED MEMBER OF SUCH INCORPORATED VOLUNTARY AMBULANCE SERVICE FOR AT LEAST FIVE YEARS. IT SHALL BE THE DUTY AND 16 17 RESPONSIBILITY OF THE MUNICIPALITY WHICH ADOPTS A LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE 18 19 OR RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION TO DETERMINE THE PROCEDURE FOR 20 CERTIFICATION.

21 3. ANY ENROLLED MEMBER OF AN INCORPORATED VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY, FIRE DEPARTMENT OR INCORPORATED VOLUNTARY AMBULANCE SERVICE WHO ACCRUES MORE 22 THAN TWENTY YEARS OF ACTIVE SERVICE AND IS SO CERTIFIED BY THE AUTHORITY 23 HAVING JURISDICTION FOR THE INCORPORATED VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY, FIRE 24 25 DEPARTMENT OR INCORPORATED VOLUNTARY AMBULANCE SERVICE, SHALL BE GRANTED THE TEN PERCENT EXEMPTION AS AUTHORIZED BY THIS SECTION FOR THE REMAIN-26 27 DER OF HIS OR HER LIFE AS LONG AS HIS OR HER PRIMARY RESIDENCE IS LOCATED WITHIN SUCH COUNTY PROVIDED THAT THE GOVERNING BODY OF A CITY, 28 VILLAGE, TOWN, SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR COUNTY, AFTER A PUBLIC HEARING, 29 30 ADOPTS A LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION PROVIDING THEREFOR.

4. APPLICATION FOR SUCH EXEMPTION SHALL BE FILED WITH THE ASSESSOR OR
OTHER AGENCY, DEPARTMENT OR OFFICE DESIGNATED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OFFERING SUCH EXEMPTION ON OR BEFORE THE TAXABLE STATUS DATE ON A FORM AS
PRESCRIBED BY THE STATE BOARD.

5. NO APPLICANT WHO IS A VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER OR VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE WORKER WHO BY REASON OF SUCH STATUS IS RECEIVING ANY BENEFIT UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION SHALL SUFFER ANY DIMINUTION OF SUCH BENEFIT BECAUSE OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

40 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-41 ing the date on which it shall have become a law and shall apply to 42 taxable status dates occurring on or after such date.
