AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to providing enhanced penalties for licensees who sell certain alcoholic beverages to persons under the age of twenty-one years

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 65 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended 2 by adding a new subdivision 3-a read as follows:
- 3 3-A. ANY LICENSEE, OR ITS AGENT OR EMPLOYEE, WHO SELLS, DELIVERS GIVES AWAY, OR CAUSES, PERMITS OR PROCURES TO BE SOLD, DELIVERED OR GIVEN AWAY TO ANY PERSON, ACTUALLY OR APPARENTLY, UNDER THE AGE OF TWEN-5 TY-ONE YEARS, ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE THAT CONTAINS MORE THAN TWO 7 CENTUM OF ALCOHOL BY VOLUME, IN COMBINATION WITH MORE THAN FIVE MILLI-GRAMS PER OUNCE OF CAFFEINE OR ANY OTHER STIMULANT INCLUDING, 8 LIMITED TO, GUARANA, GINSENG OR TAURINE THAT HAS AN EQUIVALENT EFFECT AS 9 10 SUCH QUANTITY OF CAFFEINE, SHALL BE GUILTY OF A CLASS E FELONY AS DEFINED IN THE PENAL LAW.
- 12 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 13 have become a law.
