- AN ACT to repeal certain provisions of the general municipal law relating to urban renewal agencies; to repeal certain provisions of the general municipal law relating to industrial development agencies; to repeal certain provisions of the public authorities law relating to certain authorities; to repeal article 2-D of the transportation law relating to the Utica transit authority; and to transfer any books, records and remaining rights of any dissolved authority to an identifiable location

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Legislative intent. It is hereby declared to be a substan-1 2 tial interest of this state that residents, governments and businesses 3 have certainty in the corporate status and orderly dissolution of public 4 authorities, urban renewal agencies, industrial development agencies, and parking authorities, and that upon dissolution, their enabling stat-5 6 utes will be repealed and their books, records and remaining rights, if 7 any, will be transferred to an identifiable location. The welfare of the state necessitates ensuring that the proliferation of moribund public 8 9 benefit corporations, such as those included in this act found to be defunct by the comptroller, the authorities budget office and the New 10 York state commission on public authority reform, does not 11 continue 12 unchecked.
