AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the practice of optometry

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Subparagraph (v) of paragraph (d) of 1 Section 1. subdivision 1 of section 7101-a of the education law, as added by chapter 517 of the laws 2 3 of 1995, is amended and a new subparagraph (vi) is added to read as 4 follows: 5 (v) Disclosing agents and other substances used in conjunction with б these drugs as part of a diagnostic procedure[.]; 7 SUCH ADDITIONAL CATEGORIES OF DRUGS AS MAY BE RECOMMENDED BY THE (VI) COMMISSIONER OF HEALTH IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION 8 9 TWELVE OF THIS SECTION. 10 S 2. Subparagraph (viii) of paragraph (e) of subdivision 1 of section 11 7101-a of the education law, as added by chapter 517 of the laws of 12 1995, is amended and a new subparagraph (ix) is added to read as 13 follows: 14 (viii) artificial tears and lubricants[.]; (IX) SUCH ADDITIONAL CATEGORIES OF DRUGS AS MAY BE RECOMMENDED BY 15 THE COMMISSIONER OF HEALTH IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION 16 17 TWELVE OF THIS SECTION. 18 S 3. Subdivision 1 of section 7101-a of the education law is amended 19 by adding a new paragraph (g) to read as follows:

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1 (G) PHASE THREE THERAPEUTIC PHARMACEUTICAL AGENTS. PHASE THREE THERA-2 PEUTIC PHARMACEUTICAL AGENTS SHALL MEAN THOSE ORALLY ADMINISTERED DRUGS 3 USED FOR THERAPEUTIC PURPOSES FOR THE TREATMENT OF DISEASES OF THE EYE 4 AND ADNEXA AND SHALL BE LIMITED TO:

(I) ANTIBIOTICS;

(II) DECONGESTANTS/ANTI-ALLERGENIC/ANTIHISTAMINES;

(III) ANTIGLAUCOMAS;

(IV) ANTIVIRALS;

9 (V) ANALGESICS, EXCEPT THOSE LISTED IN SCHEDULES I AND II OF THE 10 UNIFORM CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT;

(VI) NONSTEROIDAL ANTI-INFLAMMATORY DRUGS;

12 (VII) SUCH ADDITIONAL CATEGORIES OF DRUGS AS MAY BE RECOMMENDED BY THE 13 COMMISSIONER OF HEALTH IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION 14 TWELVE OF THIS SECTION.

15 S 4. Paragraphs (c) and (d) of subdivision 4 of section 7101-a of the 16 education law are relettered paragraphs (d) and (e) and a new paragraph 17 (c) is added to read as follows:

(C) BEFORE USING OR PRESCRIBING ORAL PHARMACEUTICAL AGENTS, AN OPTOME-18 19 TRIST MUST BE CERTIFIED TO PRESCRIBE DIAGNOSTIC AND PHASE ONE AND PHASE TWO THERAPEUTIC PHARMACEUTICAL AGENTS AND HAVE COMPLETED A TWENTY-FIVE 20 21 HOUR PHASE THREE THERAPEUTIC PHARMACEUTICAL AGENT CERTIFICATION COURSE 22 OF DIDACTIC EDUCATION, PROVIDED BY AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY 23 APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT, WHICH SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED AND TO, INSTRUCTION IN PHARMACOLOGY AND DRUG INTERACTION. 24

25 SUCH COURSE SHALL QUALIFY TOWARDS MEETING THETHIRTY-SIX HOURS OF 26 CONTINUING EDUCATION PER TRIENNIAL REGISTRATION PERIOD REQUIRED BY 27 SUBDIVISION SEVEN OF THIS SECTION. THIS REQUIREMENT FOR THE TWENTY-FIVE 28 THREE THERAPEUTIC PHARMACEUTICAL AGENT CERTIFICATION COURSE HOUR PHASE 29 SHALL NOT APPLY TO THOSE OPTOMETRISTS WHO (I) GRADUATED FROM AN ACCRED-ITED COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY SUBSEQUENT TO JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FOUR 30 TAKEN AND SUCCESSFULLY PASSED EITHER THE TREATMENT AND 31 HAVE AND (II) 32 MANAGEMENT OF OCULAR DISEASES PORTION OF THE NATIONAL BOARD OF EXAMINERS 33 IN OPTOMETRY OR AN EXAMINATION ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD.

34 S 5. Subdivision 5 of section 7101-a of the education law, as added by 35 chapter 517 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read as follows:

5. Suspension of certification. The department 36 shall suspend the 37 certification for the use and prescribing of phase one therapeutic 38 agents of any optometrist who fails to receive certification for phase 39 two therapeutic pharmaceutical agents within three years of having been 40 certified for phase one therapeutic pharmaceutical agents. THEDEPART-MENT THE CERTIFICATION FOR THE USE AND PRESCRIBING OF 41 SHALL SUSPEND PHASE ONE AND PHASE TWO THERAPEUTIC AGENTS OF ANY OPTOMETRIST WHO FAILS 42 43 RECEIVE CERTIFICATION FOR PHASE THREE THERAPEUTIC PHARMACEUTICAL TΟ 44 AGENTS WITHIN THREE YEARS OF APPROVAL BY THE DEPARTMENT OF A TWENTY-FIVE 45 HOUR PHASE THREE THERAPEUTIC PHARMACEUTICAL AGENT CERTIFICATION COURSE PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH (C) OF SUBDIVISION FOUR OF THIS SECTION. 46

47 S 6. Subdivision 7 of section 7101-a of the education law, as added by 48 chapter 517 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read as follows:

49 7. Continuing education. Each optometrist certified to use phase one 50 or phase two therapeutic pharmaceutical agents shall complete a minimum 51 thirty-six hours of continuing education per triennial registration of period. The education shall be in the area of ocular disease and pharma-52 cology, AT LEAST SIX HOURS OF WHICH SHALL RELATE SPECIFICALLY TO SYSTEM-53 54 IC DRUG USE AND INTERACTION, and may include both didactic and clinical 55 components. Such educational programs shall be approved in advance by the department and evidence of the completion of this requirement shall 56

1 be submitted with each application for license renewal as required by 2 section sixty-five hundred two of this chapter.

3 S 7. Subdivision 12 of section 7101-a of the education law, as added 4 by chapter 517 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read as follows:

5 12. Responsibilities of the commissioner of health. The commissioner health [may recommend to the commissioner additions or deletions to 6 of 7 the department's regulations relating to optometric use of drugs except that such recommendations shall be limited only to additions which have 8 been determined to be equivalent to those drugs already authorized or 9 10 deletions based upon a finding that the drugs are no longer appropriate for their current use or for other similar reasons.] SHALL RECOMMEND 11 ΤO COMMISSIONER ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO THE LIST OF APPROVED CATEGO-12 THE RIES OF DIAGNOSTIC, THERAPEUTIC AND ORAL PHARMACEUTICAL AGENTS WHICH ARE 13 CONSISTENT WITH THE STANDARD OF CARE IN THE COMMUNITY FOR THE DIAGNOSIS 14 15 AND TREATMENT OF DISEASES OF THE EYE AND ADNEXA.

16 S 8. Section 7106 of the education law is amended by adding a new 17 subdivision 4 to read as follows:

4. BEGINNING JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND THIRTEEN, AN APPLICANT FOR A 18 19 LICENSE PURSUANT TO SECTION SEVENTY-ONE HUNDRED FOUR OF THIS ARTICLE OR RENEWAL OF A REGISTRATION IN OPTOMETRY SHALL AFFIRM TO 20 THE DEPARTMENT 21 THAT SUCH APPLICANT IS CERTIFIED IN CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR) 22 FROM AN APPROVED PROVIDER. IN THE EVENT THE APPLICANT CANNOT PHYSICALLY PERFORM CPR, THE COMMISSIONER'S REGULATIONS SHALL ALLOW THE APPLICANT TO 23 MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL IN THE OFFICE TO ADMINISTER 24 25 CPR.

S 9. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after it shall have become a law; provided that any rule or regulation necessary for the timely implementation of this act on its effective date shall be promulgated on or before such effective date.
