- AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to establishing school-outreach domestic violence prevention programs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 5 of section 459-a of the social services law, 2 as amended by chapter 169 of the laws of 1994, is amended to read as 3 follows:

4 "Non-residential program for victims of domestic violence" means 5. any program operated by a not-for-profit organization, for the purpose 5 б of providing non-residential services to victims of domestic violence, including, but not limited to, information and referral services, advo-7 8 cacy, counseling, and community education and outreach activities and 9 arranging for hotline services. Victims of domestic providing or violence and their children, if any, shall constitute at least seventy 10 11 percent of the clientele of such programs; PROVIDED THAT CLIENTELE IN A 12 SCHOOL-OUTREACH DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAM SHALL BE DISRE-13 GARDED IN MAKING THIS CALCULATION.

14 S 2. Section 459-c of the social services law is amended by adding a 15 new subdivision 3 to read as follows:

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBDIVISION AND THE 16 3. (A) REGULATIONS OF THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY 17 SERVICES, A SOCIAL SERVICES DISTRICT SHALL PURCHASE FROM A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION 18 19 OPERATING A NON-RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM FOR VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND PROVIDE TO STUDENTS WITHIN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE HIGH SCHOOL SETTINGS A 20 PROGRAM OF INFORMATION AND REFERRAL SERVICES, ADVOCACY, COUNSELING, AND 21 EDUCATION ABOUT DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. 22

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1 (B) TO THE EXTENT THAT FUNDS ARE APPROPRIATED EXPRESSLY THEREFOR, 2 STATE REIMBURSEMENT SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR ONE HUNDRED PERCENT OF THE 3 EXPENDITURES MADE BY A SOCIAL SERVICES DISTRICT FOR PROGRAMS PROVIDED 4 PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS SUBDIVISION.

5 S 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 6 it shall have become a law; provided that the commissioner of the office 7 of children and family services is authorized to promulgate any and all 8 rules and regulations and take any other measures necessary to implement 9 this act on its effective date on or before such date.
