AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibiting the use of salt in the preparation of food by restaurants

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 399-ccc to read as follows:

3 S 399-CCC. PROHIBITION ON SALT; RESTAURANTS. 1. NO OWNER OR OPERATOR 4 OF A RESTAURANT IN THIS STATE SHALL USE SALT IN ANY FORM IN THE PREPARA-5 TION OF ANY FOOD FOR CONSUMPTION BY CUSTOMERS OF SUCH RESTAURANT, 6 INCLUDING FOOD PREPARED TO BE CONSUMED ON THE PREMISES OF SUCH RESTAU-7 RANT OR OFF OF SUCH PREMISES.

8 2. WHENEVER THERE SHALL BE A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION AN APPLICATION 9 BE MADE BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL IN THE NAME OF THE PEOPLE OF THE MAY STATE OF NEW YORK TO A COURT OR JUSTICE HAVING JURISDICTION BY A SPECIAL 10 PROCEEDING TO ISSUE AN INJUNCTION, AND UPON NOTICE TO THE DEFENDANT OF 11 LESS THAN FIVE DAYS, TO ENJOIN AND RESTRAIN THE CONTINUANCE OF SUCH 12 NOT VIOLATIONS; AND IF IT SHALL APPEAR TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE 13 COURT OR 14 JUSTICE THAT THE DEFENDANT HAS, IN FACT, VIOLATED THIS SECTION, AN COURT OR JUSTICE, 15 INJUNCTION MAY BE ISSUED BY THE ENJOINING AND RESTRAINING ANY FURTHER VIOLATIONS, 16 WITHOUT REQUIRING PROOF THAT ANY 17 PERSON HAS, IN FACT, BEEN INJURED OR DAMAGED THEREBY. ΙN ANY SUCH PROCEEDING, THE COURT MAY MAKE ALLOWANCES TO THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AS 18 19 PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH SIX OF SUBDIVISION (A) OF SECTION EIGHTY-THREE 20 THREE OF THE CIVIL PRACTICE LAW AND RULES, AND DIRECT RESTITU-HUNDRED TION. WHENEVER THE COURT 21 SHALL DETERMINE THAT A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION HAS OCCURRED, THE COURT MAY IMPOSE A CIVIL PENALTY OF NOT MORE 22 23 THAN ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR EACH VIOLATION. EACH USE OF SALT IN SHALL CONSTITUTE A SEPARATE VIOLATION. IN 24 VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION 25 CONNECTION WITH ANY SUCH PROPOSED APPLICATION, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL IS
