AN ACT to amend the New York state urban development corporation act, in relation to the establishment of an African-American and African-Caribbean business development center

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 174 of the laws of 1968, constituting the New York state urban development corporation act, is amended by adding a new section 9-g to read as follows:
- CREATING AN AFRICAN-AMERICAN AND AFRICAN-CARIBBEAN BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CENTER. THE CORPORATION SHALL PROVIDE, WITH THE ASSISTANCE THE COMMISSIONER OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND IN CONSULTATION WITH SUCH COMMISSIONER, AN AFRICAN-AMERICAN AND AFRICAN-CARIBBEAN FOR THE PURPOSES OF RENDERING TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE DEVELOPMENT CENTER AND MARKET INFORMATION TO NOT-FOR-PROFIT SERVICE PROVIDERS AND THE 10 PRIVATE BUSINESSES SERVICING AFRICAN-AMERICAN AND AFRICAN-CARIBBEAN
