AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to veterans and competitive civil service exam points

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of section 85 of the civil service law, as amended by chapter 333 of the laws of 1993, is amended to read as follows:
 - (a) The terms "veteran" and "non-disabled veteran" mean:
- (1) a member of the armed forces of the United States who served therin time of war, who was honorably discharged or released under honorable circumstances from such service, who is a citizen of United States or an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence in the United States and who is a resident of the state of New York at the time of application for appointment or promotion or at the time of retention, as the case may be; OR
- (2) A MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES WHO WAS HONOR-ABLY DISCHARGED OR RELEASED UNDER HONORABLE CIRCUMSTANCES FROM SUCH 13 14 SERVICE, WHO IS A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES OR AN ALIEN 15 ADMITTED FOR PERMANENT RESIDENCE IN THE UNITED STATES, WHO IS A RESIDENT THE STATE OF NEW YORK AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT OR 16 PROMOTION OR AT THE TIME OF RETENTION, AS THE CASE MAY BE, AND WHO WAS 17
