AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system in the town of Islip as the "Grace Peshkur Memorial Bridge"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 342-kk to read as follows:

- S 342-KK. PORTION OF STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE "GRACE PESHKUR MEMORIAL BRIDGE". THE BRIDGE ON WAVERLY AVENUE WHICH CROSSES INTERSTATE ROUTE 495 IN THE TOWN OF ISLIP, COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, SHALL BE DESIGNATED AND KNOWN AS THE "GRACE PESHKUR MEMORIAL BRIDGE".
- S 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge shall not be
