AN ACT authorizing the assessor of the town of Islip to accept an application for exemption from real property taxes from Plumbers Local Union No. 200 Apprenticeship Training Fund for certain parcels of land located in the town of Islip

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1.   Notwithstanding any other provision of any law to the  
2     contrary, the assessor of the town of Islip is hereby authorized to  
3     accept from Plumbers Local Union No. 200 Apprenticeship Training Fund,  
4     an application for exemption from real property taxes pursuant to  
5     section 420-a of the real property tax law for 2009-2010 and 2010-2011  
6     assessment rolls for the parcel located at 370 Central Avenue, Bohemia,  
7     New York, 11716, also known as Lot 4.3 of Block 2 of Section 174 of  
8     District 500. If accepted, the application shall be reviewed as if it  
9     had been received on or before the taxable status date established for  
10    such rolls.

11    If satisfied that Plumbers Local Union No. 200 Apprenticeship Training  
12    Fund, would otherwise be entitled to such exemption if it had filed an

1 application for exemption by the appropriate taxable status date, the  
2 assessor, upon approval by the town board, may grant exemption from  
3 taxation beginning with the date of acquisition of the property by Plum-  
4 bers Local Union No. 200 Apprenticeship Training Fund, and make appro-  
5 priate correction of these subject rolls. If such exemption is granted  
6 and if Plumbers Local Union No. 200 Apprenticeship Training Fund, shall  
7 have paid any tax with respect to such subject rolls, the governing body  
8 or tax department may, in its sole discretion, provide for the refund of  
9 those taxes paid and cancel taxes, fines, penalties or interest remain-  
10 ing unpaid.

11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
